No post dated cheques accepted. A post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes - it will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic

submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

PLEASE USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR ALASKAN MALAMUTES

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open

Veterans Specials Only Exhibition Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES: Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - Stud dog and two or more of his get, ownership need not be identical. Stud dog may be neutered.

Brood Bitch Class - Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, ownership need not be identical. Brood bitch may be spayed,

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed & colour

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<u>Note:</u> All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

SPECIALTY SWEEPSTAKES

6-18 MONTHS – The following classes are offered: Junior (6-9 months), Senior (9-12 months), Open (12-18 months) on the day of the specialty. Classes are divided by sex. First Place winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the Regular Classes at the Specialty.

VETERAN – The following classes are offered: 7 to 10 years, 10 to 13 years, 13 years and older on the day of the specialty. Classes are divided by sex. First Place winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the Official Classes at the Specialty. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete.

SPECIALTY SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES – Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows: 25% of total fees will be retained by the club for administration. Best in Sweepstakes will receive 25% of total entry fee. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive 20% of total entry fee. First Place winners in each class will divide the remaining 30% of the total entry fee.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- 3. Telephone and telegraph entries are prohibited under CKC rules.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 5. Changes, cancellations, or substitutions after Closing Date are prohibited.
- 6. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 7. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.
- 8. All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN number simply do the following. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount prescribed payable to the Canadian Kennel Club Ensure that you provide CKC with your full return address. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a C.K.C. event. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to apply for the ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one

fo the regular official classes.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- All Rules and Regulations pertaining to the All-Breed Show are applicable to this Specialty Show.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler.

- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The Specialty Club and St. John's Recreational Center will not be held responsible for any
 equipment left on the grounds overnight.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the
 progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that
 this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- The Specialty Club and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of
 the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event
 of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because
 of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the AMCC and their Show
 Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted on the show premises.
- No dogs shall be permitted to remain in the building overnight
- The precincts of the show shall be the building and the entrances to it.
