

OFFICIAL JUNIOR HANDLING

There will be Junior Handling **CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE** Saturday and Sunday. Registration will be in the Show Secretary's room in the morning, and must be done at least one hour in advance of the scheduled judging. Dogs competing in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the regular classes or in Exhibition Only. A fee of \$2.00 for Junior Handling is required at time of registration. Advanced notice of Obedience entry would be appreciated.

GENERAL INFORMATION

THE PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW WILL BE THE SHOW BUILDING AND ENTRANCE. The show premises will be Opening at 7:00 am each day and on Friday March 18 from 5:00-8:00pm (sharp) for early set up. The Show/Trial Judging will start at 9:00am unless entries warrant an earlier start. Judging schedule and identification will be mailed as soon as possible after the entry closing date. Identification of an accepted entry for dogs must be presented at the entrance to the show premises, and only dogs entered in the shows and trials will be permitted to enter the venue. The Cobequid Dog Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have his/her dog in the ring when required. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the shows and trials. Exercise pens will be restricted at the discretion of the Show Superintendent. Only dogs entered in the show are permitted within the show precincts please. Electrical outlets will not be available to exhibitors. CANTEEN service provided.

Rule 12.2.2 Puppies 3-6 Months

a) Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.
b) Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes including parades nor are they required to be listed in the catalogue.

One puppy per exhibitor will be permitted at this show.

CHAPTER 8, SECTION 8 OF THE DOG SHOW RULES: A Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to INDIGNITIES of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

ENTRIES (including G.S.T)

Payment by Cash, Check or Money Order – Payable to the Cobequid Dog Club

Entry per Dog per Show or Trial \$23.00

Exhibition Only per Dog per Show or Trial \$7.00

Listing Fee per Show or Trial \$9.55

Please Note: Credit card payments/ Fax Entries accepted ONLY through THE ENTRY LINE

*A Canadian Kennel Club Listing Fee is payable if entry does not include a CKC Individual number. Litter Registration numbers are not acceptable. To compete in the Non-Regular classes, the dog must be entered in regular classes or as Exhibition Only. To facilitate setting up jumps, please include your dog's height.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

NOTE

All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via The Entry Line. The Cobequid Dog Club does not accept credit cards for payment.

CLASSIFICATION

CONFORMATION: For definition see reverse of entry forms

OBEDIENCE TRIALS: Pre-Novice, Novice "A" "B" "C" and Novice Intermediate, Open "A" and "B", Utility A bitch in season may not compete at Licensed Obedience Trials. Entry fees will only be refunded if a Veterinarian's Certificate to this effect is received by the Show Secretary at least **one hour before** the commencement of the trial.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms

Novice A for dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and is handled by the owner or immediate family member

Novice B For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.

Advanced A for dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member

Advanced B For any dog that has earned the RN title.

Excellent A for dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member

Excellent B For any dog that has earned the RA title.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at any All Breed Championship Show will be credited with Five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1.Attention U.S. Exhibitors: A Personal cheque will be accepted, however, it must be payable in US funds and for the full entry amount. Personally discounted cheques will not be accepted. Do not mark cheque "payable in Canadian" or "funds at par". Your co-operation is appreciated.
- 2.If entering the same dog in conformation, obedience or exhibition only please use a separate entry form for each class.
- 3.An **INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORM WILL BE RETURNED.** Please ensure that your postal code is included. **ALL NSF CHEQUES WILL BE CHARGED A \$20.00 SERVICE CHARGE.**
- 4.Exhibitors must abide by the errors made when making the entry, regardless how or who made the entry.
- 5.An entry will not be accepted unless accompanied by the required fees.
- 6.The Cobequid Dog Club reserves the right to reject any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 7.Only dogs, which are eligible for registration or are registered by the CKC, may be entered in these Show & Trials.
- 8.Overpayment of entry fees up to a maximum of \$5.00 will be considered a donation to Cobequid Dog Club Trophy Fund.
- 9.The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the CKC.
10. **There will be no prong or spike collars permitted at this venue.**
11. Conformation Show - Move Up Chapter 13, Sec. 13, of the Dog Show Rules:
"A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and has completed the requirements of championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of these rules, after closing date and time for entries of the show, but whose championship is unconfirmed by CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the request for transfer is submitted by owner or handler to the Show Secretary, **IN WRITING**, at least one hour prior to the opening of the show."
12. Obedience Trial – Move Up
A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title, in accordance with Section 9.4.2 and 10.4.2 of the Obedience Rules, may be moved to the next level of Obedience competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial secretary, **IN WRITING** by the owner or handler, one hour prior to the opening of the first trial, trial schedule permitting.
