

Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

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- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian a) non-member of CKC.
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to b) become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Points Are Not Awarded to Incorrect or Incomplete Entries

- When a dog is co-owned, the names of all owners must appear on the entry form.
- Enter the dog under its registered name, not its call name or another dog's name. The only exception is with listed dogs where the name may change upon registration.
- A foreign dog registered in another country must be entered under its registered name in the • country of origin.
