I teach rally obedience, and was given an opportunity to submit input on the development of Rally Obedience here in Canada. I hope to become a Rally judge as well, at some point.

My first Sam came to me in 1976, a rescue from a local shelter. I bought my first registered Samoyed in 1978, and attended my first dog show that same year. That first bit of satin ribbon hooked me!

I met my husband, Paul, when I bred my first litter, and he came to buy a puppy...

Under the Sancha kennel name, my husband Paul and I have bred 60 Champion Samoyeds to date, mostly owner-handled, until very recently, We also bred and owned Pembroke Welsh Corgis, and have had two Champions. We have been honoured to win Best in Show, Best Puppy in Show, and many Group wins and placements with our dogs. Along the way, I finished a CDX on my first Sam, and CD titles on a number of others. We have also worked our Sams from time to time in harness: sledding, carting, and ski-joring, as well as in herding.

I handled many other breeds in conformation at one time, including Siberian Huskies, Norwegian Elkhounds, Bearded Collies, Rough Collies, and Belgian Shepherds. In 2007, I applied for my Conformation judging permit, and I can now judge the entire Working Group.

Along the way I have had the pleasure of judging Sweepstakes for a number of regional Specialties: the Willamette Valley Samoyed Fanciers, the Samoyed Club of Washington State, and in Canada, for Akitas, Boxers, Bullmastiffs, Siberian Huskies, Standard Schnauzers, and several Group 5 Specialties, and for the Mastiff Club of Canada and Shiba Inu Canada National Specialties. In October 2011, I was honoured to be chosen as the Breed judge for the Edmonton Samoyed Club Annual Regional Specialty.

I retired from the Provincial Government in 2006, after 30 years, where I worked in the Ministry of Finance. My other hobbies include gardening and growing orchids.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) the number of championship points shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

A Dog may not be credited with more than 5 points in a single show.
10 points (which includes at least one 2 point win) awarded by at least 3 different judges are needed to obtain a CKC Championship.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

- 1. All dogs six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age shall be eligible to compete
- 2. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular Breed classes

The classes in the Sweepstakes are divided by sex and offered as follows:
Junior Puppy (6 months and less than 9 months)
Senior Puppy (9 months and less than 12 months)
12-18 Months (12 months and less than 18 months)

For final judging, the first place dog from each of the above classes will be brought together for the final placing of “Best in Sweepstakes” and “Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes”

PRIZES

Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 20% of the Entry Fees received and a Rosette, Metal Art Mastiff Garden Stake, Suitable Prize from Royal Canin, Baskerville Mastiffs Perpetual Trophy keeper plaque

Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 15% of the Entry Fees received, Mastiff Coat Hook and a Rosette

First Place winners in each class 25% of class entry fees, Logo Retractable Belt Clip and a Rosette

Second Place in each class 10% of class entry fees and a Rosette

Third Place in each class 5% of class entry fees and a Rosette

Fourth Place in each class Rosette

The Club will retain the remaining 25% to defray costs.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

- 1. All dogs seven (7) years of age and over shall be eligible to compete
- 2. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular Breed classes or for Exhibition Only

The classes in the Sweepstakes are divided by sex and offered as follows:
7 Years of Age and under 9 Years of Age
9 Years of Age and over

For final judging, the first place dog from each of the above classes will be brought together for the final placing of “Best in Sweepstakes” and “Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes”

PRIZES

Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 20% of the Entry Fees Received. Metal Art Mastiff Garden Stake, Suitable Prize from Royal Canin and a Rosette

Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 15% of the Entry Fees received, Mastiff Coat Hook and a Rosette

First Place winners in each class 10% of entry fees, Retractable Belt Clip w/Slobber Rag and a Rosette

Second Place to Fourth Place in each class will receive a Rosette

The Club will retain the remaining 25% to defray costs.

CLASSIFICATION

The following classes are offered and will be divided by SEX

REGULAR CLASSES

Junior Puppy	6 months of age and less than 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	9 months of age and less than 12 months of age
12—18 Months	12 months of age and less than 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	For dogs born in Canada. Champions in any country excluded
Bred by Exhibitor	For any dog handled in the ring by its owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND the breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, (but need not handle the dog for further awards.★) *** See Special BBE Award ***
Open	For all dogs.
Veteran	For dogs over 7 years of age at the date of the show. (Classes are 7 up to 9 & 9+) Veterans Class winners will not compete for points but will proceed directly into the Best of Breed competition. SPAYED/NEUTERED DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THIS CLASS
Specials Only	Dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration number or Event Registration number and have attained the required points for championship status. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, and Best Puppy if eligible.
NON-REGULAR CLASSES	
Exhibition Only	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any of the Regular Classes
Brace Class	For 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex), judged as an identical pair. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. Need not be identical ownership.
Stud Dog/Dam and Get/Progeny Class	For the Sire/Dam and two or more of his/her Get/Progeny. To enter this class the Sire/Dam must be entered in one of the Regular classes, or Exhibition Only. Get/Progeny MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

For surgically neutered/spayed dogs 6 months of age or older. There are NO classes other than OPEN. Class will be divided by sex. Awards will include the following: Best Altered in Breed, Best of Opposite Sex-Altered, Winners Altered Male/Female, Reserve Winners Altered Male/Female, First to Fourth in each class. Points awarded in the same manner as Regular Competition judging. Points may NOT be carried over into these classes from regular competition judging. Classes will be judged immediately following the Regular breed classes. For further information, please see the Dog Show Rules—Chapter 4

BABY PUPPY

This is a new class approved by the CKC for 2012 open to puppies between the ages of 3-6 months. No points are awarded to Baby Puppies, rather it is handled as an exhibition only. Placements are awarded first through fourth for each sex with Best Baby Puppy Male and Best Baby Puppy Female awarded respectively. Immediately thereafter a Best Baby Puppy in Specialty is chosen. (Unlike the 6-9 month puppies, the Baby puppies are not required to enter the ring after Best of Breed.) note: “Judges should not disqualify dogs in this class for lack of testicles or not meeting a minimum height requirement required in the breed standard.”

For the award of Best Canadian Bred in Specialty, all Canadian bred dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another Canadian bred dog shall be eligible to compete for this award. The dog need not be entered in the Canadian-bred class.

For the award of Best Puppy in Specialty, all puppies 6 months and under 12 months on the day of the show, having not been defeated directly or indirectly by another puppy shall be eligible to compete for this award. The dog need not be entered in the puppy classes.

Challenge Trophy

BEST OF WINNERS - The Hyacinth Mellish Challenge Trophy - donated by Gladys Tangen & Martha Beswick. (To be won outright when won 3 times by the same owner, but not necessarily the same dog.) A keeper trophy shall be presented.

*** Special Award ***

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR - a rosette and trophy shall be presented. For the award of Best Bred By Exhibitor in Specialty, all breeder/owner handled dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another breeder/owner-handled dog shall be eligible to compete for this award. I. Purpose

The Purpose of the Tournament of Champions is to recognize and reward those Mastiffs that have achieved Championship status with either CKC or AKC. It is an opportunity to further showcase these Specials dogs in an event other than Best of Breed competition. Utilizing this unique judging panel, we enable judges, handlers, breeders and spectators alike, the ability to examine some of the finest examples of the breed. Each entrant will receive a participation medallion to commemorate the event. The Winners will be announced at the Banquet Saturday night. Our three person judging panel has been carefully chosen to include a CKC Licensed Judge for Mastiffs, a Mastiff Breeder and a Professional Handler of Mastiffs. II. Eligibility

- a) Dog must be a Champion of Record with either CKC or AKC at the time of closing.
- b) Dog must be entered in one of the regular classes, or exhibition only, at the CMC National Specialty Show.
- c) Dog must not be neutered or spayed.
- d) Dog must be handled by the owner of record at time of closing.
- e) Dog entered is not from a breeding where one of the judges is or has been an owner of record of the dog or of its sire or dam.
- f) Dog may not be entered under a judge that has handled for an owner of said dog within 6 months prior to the show or any other circumstance listed in Sections 4.1.6, 4.1.7 or 4.1.10 of the CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations.
- g) If an entry is made in contradiction to the Rules of Eligibility, that entry will be disqualified.
- h) After individual judging, if an owner has 2 or more dogs required in the ring at the same time, another handler may be used.

III. Sequence of Judging

- a) Dogs will enter the ring in numerical order to be checked in, Males first.
- b) Males will be judged first, 3 dogs at a time.
- c) All others will be released to the holding area until it is time for their group to be judged.
- d) After all the dogs have been judged and scored those that have made the cut will be asked to return to the ring for further judging.

EXTRACTS FROM CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a “listed” dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$9.40 must accompany the entry of a “listed” dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 2.3:

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being canceled, and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.2:

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16,

Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules

CHAPTER 9 - EXHIBITORS and THEIR DOGS

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ADDITIONAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

1. The Canadian Mastiff Club will exercise due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs, exhibitors, handlers, spectators and vendors, but will not be responsible for any personal injury or death of any person or animal, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune, nor for any damage, loss or theft of personal property.

2. All persons attending this event hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club, their members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation.

3. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct of their animals while they are on the show grounds. ALL DOGS must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

4. The CMC reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed. CASH PRIZES will be handed over in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over. The Club disclaims any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

5. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from these shows, which will be held strictly under the Canadian Kennel Club Rules.

6. The welfare of any children is deemed to be the responsibility of the guardian or parent. Please exercise control and restraint over your child's behavior.

7. Dogs must be ready for judging. The Club will not be responsible for, and not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. NO RING WILL BE HELD UP WAITING FOR EXHIBITORS OR HANDLERS.

8. All trailers, motor homes, campers and recreational units will have buckets underneath their sink drains. Anyone found discharging black or gray water from their unit will immediately be removed from the grounds.

9. EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only. Failure to comply may result in future entries being refused.

10. This show will be held outdoors. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible to provide adequate shelter to protect their dogs from the sun. Exhibitors are responsible for their equipment and possessions. There will be no other facilities in case of inclement weather.

ADDITIONAL ENTRY INFORMATION

11. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
12. No refund of entry will be made due to riot, civil disturbance, "Act of God", or other reason beyond the control of the Club where it is deemed impossible to open or complete the show.
13. Corrections /cancellations must be made in writing BEFORE entries close. Substitutions or cancellations after the closing date is prohibited. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted.
14. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Incomplete entries will be returned.
