Juniors must compete in their age classification until they are old enough to move onto the next level. A \$2.00 entry fee will be collected on the day of the show. All dogs handled must be entered in the regular show in one of the official classes on Sunday, March 27, 2011.

PeeWee      4 – 6 years of age  
Junior Novice      7 years of age and up to and including 11 years of age  
(has NOT achieved 4 firsts in Novice)  
Junior Open      7 years of age and up to and including 11 years of age  
(has achieved 4 firsts in Novice)  
Senior Novice      12 years to under 18 (has NOT achieved 4 firsts in Senior Novice)  
Senior Open      12 years to under 18 (has achieved 4 firsts in Senior Novice)

### **GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE NORTHWINDS DOG CLUB**

1. Exhibitors are expected to clean up after their own dogs. Anyone caught violating this rule will be removed from the Show precincts.
2. The Show precincts will be the arena floor of the St. Norbert Community Center.
