Handlers' Meeting: Morning Event each day: 10:00 a.m.

Second Event each day: 1 hour after Morning Event

Post entries accepted if space available: Limit of 75 dogs per event

Sunday run order will be grouped by handicap: Monday run order will be by 'armband draw".

WHAT IS THE SPRINTER EVENT?

The SPRINTER EVENT is being launched by the Canadian Kennel Club on July 1, 2018. ALCA's events are the very first in Canada! The Sprinter is a fun event open to all dogs to enjoy the challenge of running a 100 meter dash. All dogs entered will receive a handicap score based on their height, and their time to finish will be converted to kilometers per hour. Titles are awarded upon the dog accumulating a given number of points.

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

SPRINTER EVENT participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
- have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.

Females in season may not compete. If in the opinion of the Event Committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season, it shall not be allowed to compete and the entry fees shall be refunded.

EARNING POINTS

The dog's time to complete the 100 meter dash is converted into Kilometers Per Hour (KPH). A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- (a) 18" or greater handicap is 1.0.
- (b) 12" up to less than 18" handicap is 1.5.
- (c) Below 12" handicap is 2.0.

Points - KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap. For example 20 KPH x 1.5 = 30 points. Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

TITLES

There are four titles dogs may earn doing the Sprinter event. They are:

Novice Sprinter (NS)

awarded to a dog that earns 150 points

Sprinter (S)

awarded to a dog that earns 500 points

Advanced Sprinter (AS)

awarded to a dog that earns 1000 points

Sprinter Excellent (SX)

awarded to a dog that earns 1500 points

Sprinter Excellent 2 (SX2)

awarded to a dog that earns 2000 points. For each additional 500 points the dog may add a higher number after the SX (SX3, SX4, etc.)

AWARDS

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog that achieves a score.

A rosette will be awarded to each dog that achieves a CKC Sprinter title.

ATTENTION

It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

ENTRY FEES

4 Sprinter Event (2 events Sunday, 2 events Monday)

Pre-entry (closes Wednesday June 27, 2018) \$20.00 per event Second & subsequent dogs \$18.00 per event

Post entry (after Wednesday June 27, 2018), if space available \$25.00 per event

Listing Fee for EACH event (Dog must be **eligible** for registration

but not yet have been registered) \$10.50 per event

Pizza lunch each day (Local Gourmet – Nitza's Pizza: 2 slices + pop) \$8.00 each day

CKC rules state that 'It is recommended that an owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed.' ALCA would like to second that to ensure a smooth running event. If you need help please let us know – experienced volunteers will be happy to slip the dog on your behalf.

INSPECTION

Two event committee members will measure your dog to determine handicap. You will also be asked to gait your dog so that soundness can be evaluated. Bitches will be checked to ensure they are not in season.

DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD

This field is east of Sherwood Park.

From South: Hwy 21 north to Wye Road. Turn right (east) on Wye Road to Township Road 524 (approx. 14 km)

Turn left on Twp Rd 524 (signed for Uncas School).

Cross RR track, proceed. School is on right side, on the corner of Rge Rd 213 & Twp Rd 524

Turn right into School Parking Lot

From Central Edmonton: Sherwood Park Freeway east, becomes Wye Rd, continue to Hwy 21.

Cross Hwy 21 and follow directions as 'From South'

From North: East on Hwy 16 to Rge Rd 213. South on Rge Rd 213 to Twp Rd 524.

Turn right at Twp Rd 524 & turn left at first driveway into school parking lot.

EQUIPMENT, FIELD CONDITIONS & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The field is a mown sport field. It is out of direct sight of roads but is not fully fenced.

- A continuous loop system will be used for the Event. A drag system will be available for back-up.
- Two timers with stopwatches will time the run. The times from the two stopwatches shall be averaged.
- Break- the beam equipment may be used to obtain the time.
- Sunday run order will be grouped by handicap
- Monday run order will be by 'armband draw'. Let's cheer on Canada's first Sprinter titlists!
- Dogs are requested to be present for inspection prior to the Handlers' Meeting. They are free to leave after completion of their run(s).
- Handlers may use a slip lead when releasing their dogs.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety.
- Dogs may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion.
- Retractable (Flexi type) leads and/shock collars are not permitted.
- The Chair may excuse any hound from participation for any reason deemed justifiable.
- A \$10.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for any dog loose on the field at any time between Roll Call and the completion of the last test.
- A \$50.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for anyone who does not clean up after their dog.
- There is limited shade and no water available, so please come PREPARED.
- Portable toilets will be available.
- ALCA, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury
 sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to
 children or spectators.
- All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals attending these shows grant the club the right to use their likeness and voice in any matter without further consent.

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS – INFO REGARDING TITLES

The following is quoted from the CKC website:

"The following non-member participation fee now applies and is retroactive to January 1, 2011.

The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members and a participating non-member can chose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."
