Veterans Class For dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show.
(Dogs entered in this class may be neutered/spayed)

Non-Regular Classes

**All dogs entered in the non-regular classes must be entered in a regular class in the
specialty or in Exhibition Only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

Brace: Two dogs shown on a single lead. **OWNERSHIP** of the two dogs
do NOT need to be **IDENTICAL** (*New Rules).

Stud Dog: A dog and at least two of his get. (Breeders/Owners **need NOT**
be identical)

Brood Bitch: A brood bitch and at least two of her progeny. (Breeders/Owners
need NOT be identical)

Stripped Down: Length of hair CANNOT be longer than 1 inch on any portion of
the body, with the exception of the ear, where there will be
no length requirement.

Best Gait, Open to any dog or bitch. Dogs and bitches will be judged together.
Head, Front , Rear:

PARADE OF CHAMPIONS: for all CKC. recognized champions. Dogs must be entered
in a Regular Class or in Exhibition Only. Please enclose a resume of your champion to be
printed in the show catalogue and to be announced as the dog parades around the
ring. (maximum 100 words) Resumes may be sent with entry or e-mail to woof@tbaytel.net,
