Per Lundström will judge all Regular Classes (including 12-15 mo, 15-18 mo, Veterans), Baby Puppy, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, Team, Canadian Bred, Best Veteran, Sexually Altered and Award of Merit

I live with my wife and two children in a house in the countryside close to Stockholm, the capital of Sweden. We have four dogs and a cat at home. I was born in a home with dogs, my dad used to have Great Danes and I think my fascination for the Irish Wolfhound is

out of his interest in the GD and other big breeds. We also had Kleine Munsterländer at home. But as a child you want to do your own thing...

My first litter was born in 1989 with the prefix Pre-Eminence's, at that time I also bred miniature wired haired Dachshunds. I have also been co-breeder of 15 Afghan litters where several of them have been very successful both in LC and in the show ring.

After a car accident in 1997, I'm only breeding the IW's. I was unable to walk for about one year and it took me some time to get going again and in 1999 I was well enough to have a litter of IW puppies again, under a new prefix Greirish. So far, I have bred, handled and owned more than 50 champions, several of them with titles also in the other Nordic countries. I have also bred top winning LC dogs.

I have judged open shows since 1994 and given CC since 2002 licensed by The Swedish Kennel Club & FCI. So far I have judged in America, Australia, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, England, Estonia, France, Finland, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Northern Ireland, Norway, Poland, Slovakia and Sweden.

I judge and give CC to all Sighthounds and Basenji in FCI group 5 and the whole FCI group 10. I also give CC in the following breeds; FCI group 2; Great Dane, Schnauzer, Miniature Schnauzer, Miniature Pinscher. FCI group 4, all verities and sizes of Dachshund, FCI group 6, Beagle, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Dalmatian. FCI group 8, Portuguese Water Dog.

I have also given seminars in conformation and arranged some seminars for Sighthounds and breed seminars for Afghans and Irish Wolfhounds. I was one of the organizers for the Afghan Hound World congress 2008.

Because of my accident I only work part time as a Senior Adviser at a Swedish Retail bank called SEB.

I'm really looking forward to this assignment and I hope we will have a lovely weekend together.

I am so honored to be invited to judge your youngsters in the sweepstakes classes. It is so much fun to see all of the puppies and nothing is ever more fun then spending the day with Irish Wolfhounds. I am also looking forward to the unofficial classes

and really hope we have some junior showmanship entries.

My wife Marci and I (often referred to as M & M) live in the Coast Range of Oregon near the small town of Vernonia (Discovery channel The Axemen). Entries for all Regular/Non-regular/Unofficial/Sexually Altered and Parade of Veterans must be noted on the Official CKC entry form. Each dog entered in one or more of Non-regular/Unofficial classes MUST be entered in one of the Regular classes, "Specials Only", Sexually Altered or Exhibition Only. Each dog entered in the Parade of Veterans MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes, "Specials Only" or Exhibition Only. Note that the Parade of Veterans is NOT the same as the Veteran Class. The COMPETITIVE VETERANS CLASS is a regular class at Specialty Shows (Chapter 3, sec.3.2.1(g), Dog Show Rules).

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Effective January 1, 2011:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry will be accepted. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks. Your cooperation is appreciated

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4 - Section 4.7.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded WINNERS at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth

or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.

- Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed or emailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- 6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered nonpayment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$35.00 service charge.
- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Irish Wolfhound Club of Canada will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several dogs must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times conflict.
 5. SHOW PRECINCES. The Show precincts shell consist of all ages set out.
- 5. SHOW PRECINCTS: The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers, and an area of 10 feet outside of the judging rings. In the event of inclement weather, no provisions have been made for cover.

The IWCC will offer a Best Canadian Bred in Specialty. All Canadian bred dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another Canadian bred dog shall be eligible to compete for this award. Undefeated Canadian Bred class hounds will have to be brought back into the ring to be considered for this award. The awarding of an AOM to a Canadian Bred will be considered in the elimination process of who shall compete for Best Canadian Bred

The IWCC will offer a Best Veteran in Specialty to be chosen from Best Veteran Bitch and Best Veteran Dog. The awarding of an AOM to a Veteran will be considered in the elimination process. Best Veteran will be chosen at the time of Best of Breed judging.

All rules and regulations in the CKC Dog Show rules shall apply to this class. All disqualifications shall apply except for those which disallow sexually altered dogs from regular conformation competition. Judges shall judge this class as if judging regular conformation classes. Withholding awards for lack of merit is encouraged. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. These classes will be judged after the judging of the Best of Breed in the Regular classes and before the non-regular judging. Official Sexually Altered Classes: One class for Males and one class for Females, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered will be offered at this show.

At the judge's discretion, The IWCC will offer one Award of Merit for every 10 dogs competing at Best of Breed level. Awards of Merit cannot be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Select Bitch but may be awarded to any other dog in the Best of Breed Ring not in a placement position. If more than one Award of Merit can be presented, the AOMs will be considered to be of equal value and not ranked. Trophies and Rosettes will be offered

BEST BABY PUPPY IN SPECIALTY The IWCC will offer a Best Baby Puppy in Specialty to be chosen between Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female. There are no points awarded for these classes.

The IWCC will offer Trophies and Rosettes for Select Dog and Select Bitch
