JUNIOR OPEN CLASS: THIS CLASS IS FOR HANDLERS 7 TO 10 YEARS OF AGE AS OF DECEMBER 31ST OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE COMPETITION YEAR, WHO HAVE WON 6 FIRST PLACES IN THE SAME CLASS WITH COMPETITION.

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS: THIS CLASS IS FOR HANDLERS 11 TO 14 YEARS OF AGE AS OF DECEMBER 31⁵¹ OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE COMPETITION YEAR, WHO HAVE NOT WON 6 FIRST PLACES IN THE SAME CLASS WITH COMPETITION.

INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS: THIS CLASS IS FOR HANDLERS 11 TO 14 YEARS OF AGE AS OF DECEMBER 31ST OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE COMPETITION YEAR, WHO HAVE WON 6 FIRST PLACES IN THE SAME CLASS WITH COMPETITION AND FOR ANY HANDLER WHO HAS PROGRESSED THROUGH THE JUNIOR OPEN LEVEL AND FEELS THAT HE HAS ENOUGH EXPERIENCE TO COMPLETE AT THIS LEVEL.

SENIOR NOVICE CLASS: THIS CLASS IS FOR HANDLERS 15 YEAR OF AGE AS OF DECEMBER 31⁵⁷ OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE COMPETITION YEAR AND UP TO 18 YEARS OF AGE, WHO HAVE NOT WON 6 FIRST PLACES WITH COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS. HANDLERS FROM THE INTERMEDIATE LEVELS PROGRESS TO THIS CLASS.

SENIOR OPEN CLASS: THIS CLASS IS FOR HANDLERS 15 YEAR OF AGE AS OF DECEMBER 31ST OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE COMPETITION YEAR AND UP TO 18 YEARS OF AGE, WHO HAVE WON 6 FIRST PLACES WITH COMPETITION IN THE SENIOR NOVICE CLASS AND FOR ANY HANDLER WHO HAS PROGRESSED THROUGH THE INTERMEDIATE OPEN LEVEL AND FEELS THAT HE HAS ENOUGH EXPERIENCE TO COMPETE AT THIS LEVEL.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above Shows and Trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.

2. The Show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.

3. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the Show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the Rule, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this Rule has been violated.

Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds.

5. Dogs must be on the Grounds one hour before the judging of their Breeds, and may be removed when not required for further judging.

6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to proved any service for notifying owners or agents of Breed or Class Judging. No Ring shall be held up waiting Exhibitors or Handlers. Exhibitors and Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute Handlers available so that judging will not be delayed.

7. The owner of a dog entered in these Shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the Entry was made.

8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship Show held under these Rules cannot again be shown at a Show held under these Rules until the dog has been examined by an Official Committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the Examining Committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

9. Exhibitors and Handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.

10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the Exhibitors and the Spectators we insist upon keeping our Grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please Exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging Ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, NOT in the vicinity of the Ring areas.

11. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fore, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

12. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

13. The use of PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM will be kept to an absolute minimum. Therefore, IT WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS TO HAVE THEIR DOGS AT RINGSIDE, when necessary. There will be no paging for individual dogs.

14. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the Grounds for the duration of the shows.

PLEASE KEEP THE SHOW GROUNDS CLEAN! - PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!

PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES AND ENTRY INFORMATION

Please note - CKC Rule * Once entered in a LIMITED SHOW an entry may NOT be pulled at any time *

1. All personal Cheques tendered in payment of entry fees must be made payable to - ANNE NEFF

Telephone and Telegraph entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as Board of Directors may otherwise authorize.

3. Incomplete, conditional entries, or entries received without fees will not be accepted. All entries must be signed in ink by the owner or agent responsible for the entry and must be made out on the Official Entry Form or reasonable facsimile of same.

4. Tendering of POST DATED CHEQUES is considered NON-PAYMENT of entry fee.

5. Tendering of NSF cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

6. If a dog is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has competed the Requirements for Championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the CKC Rules. After the closing date and time for entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed by the CKC, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to 'Specials Only' providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing at least one hour prior to the opening of the show by the owner or handler.

INFORMATION ON THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

THE AUTHORITIES OF ANY SHOW MAY:

(A) Decline to accept entries for just cause and/or

(B) Refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.

In the case of Non-acceptance, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have claim or recourse against the organization holding the show, or any official connected therewith for the refusal of any entry.

ATTENTION: FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you sent a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please DO NOT make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds.

BORDER CROSSING:

A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this Certificate and MUST be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry into the US

IN THE EVENT OF A POSTAL STRIKE:

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. The "Dog Show Rules" and "Obedience Regulations" are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS: For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC degrees and titles, individual registration will no longer be required for foreign born, foreign owned, dogs instead they may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (currently \$53.50) with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering events only)

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The system provides for additional Points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN) (3) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.
