Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques & declined credit cards will be assessed a \$25.00 service charge (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules). Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Event Secretary after the closing time and date. Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

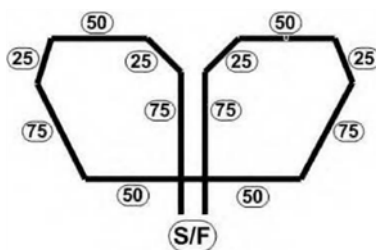
NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

The owner of a dog entered in this event is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy fund. Thank you!

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the event.



600 Yards

Course will be reversed for the second event. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the event.

300 YARD COURSE: This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers or brachycephalic (“flat-faced”) dogs. Dogs will run one loop.

600 YARD COURSE: This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. Dogs will run both loops.

If there is a question as to which course a dog will run the judge will decide.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS: Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC; or have an Event Registration Number (ERN); or have a Performance Event Number (PEN); or eligible for registration with the CKC; or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it’s a mixed-breed. **NOTE:** Mixed Breeds and Unrecognized Breeds must have a CKC Number BEFORE they are allowed to enter any CKC event.

Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. The Chase Ability program is a pass/fail event. To earn a Pass a dog must run alone, chasing the lure and complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

RIBBONS AND TITLES:

Gold qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs passing their test.

There are three titles dogs may earn doing the Chase Ability Program. They are:

Chase Ability (CA) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges.

Chase Ability Excellent (CAX) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of ten times (CA + 7 additional passes)

Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc.)

PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE A **LIMIT OF 30 ENTRIES ACCEPTED FOR EACH EVENT.**

Additional Information

- Overnight parking permitted on field. Please park in the designated areas. Port-a-potty on site.
- Dogs will be run once.
- Lamé dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone’s safety or they shall be refunded their entry and not allowed to run. Additionally, the field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler’s discretion. No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed.
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last test.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- A veterinary clinic is within easy access from the field.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes. Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- There will be LIMITED Canteen for your eating pleasure.

ATTENTION: CANADIAN EXHIBITORS

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. **The fee is \$59.40 + 5% GST.**
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

This fee does not have to be paid before entering these events.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$59.40 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Chase Ability Rule books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
2. The Event Chairman will be in full charge of the events which will be governed by CKC rules.
3. Entries made through Dogshow.ca will be acknowledged by email, with receipt. A judging schedule **will not** be published.
4. **If entries are emailed to the Event Secretary, they must be accompanied by an e-transfer or PayPal transfer of all fees to: scoctreasurer@gmail.com** They will be acknowledged, but please be patient.
5. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7
6. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the event secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

Directions to the field: Approximate GPS coordinates N51.91022 W 107.091402

The field is about 4 km southeast of Delisle, at the intersection of Range Road 3084 (Durham Road) and Township Road 342. If you are coming north from Calgary on #7, turn Right on #766 just as you are about to leave Delisle, and right at the first turn past the feedlot. The Pattison farm (big red barn, metal roof) is the first place you come to; the field is across the road from the buildings, on the right.

If you are coming from Saskatoon on #7, turn left about 10 km past Vanscoy, onto Durham Road. The Pattison farm is the second place you come to (the first is a house very close to the highway).

In consideration of acceptance of the entry and the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons or prizes at the Chase Ability events to be held on September 8, 2017, I agree:

1. To hold the Saluki Club of Canada including their members, directors, officers and employees (collectively defined as the "SCOC"), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim;
2. To hold the SCOC harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the SCOC or any other person(s);
3. Assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the SCOC harmless from any and all loss and expense, including legal fees, by reason of the liability imposed by law upon the SCOC for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person(s), including myself, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in the event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the SCOC or any other person(s);
4. That any cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the attendance at the event between the SCOC and myself or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this waiver shall be settled by arbitration in the province of Alberta; and
