WHAT IS THE CHASE ABILITY PROGRAM (CAP) TEST?

This exciting event, developed after the ever-popular Lure Coursing, allows dogs to uncover their natural prey drive through chasing a lure - all while having lots of fun. The Chase Ability Test also provides purebreds and mixed-breeds with the opportunity to compete and earn multiple titles and certificates in a field event that all dogs are capable of performing.

Two types of courses will be available: one for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers or brachycephalic dogs and another course for the remainder of the dogs entered. The Chase Ability program is a pass/fail event. How does your Dog earn a Pass? A dog must run alone, chasing the lure and complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS

Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
- have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.

Females in season may not compete.

If in the opinion of the Test Committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season, it shall not be allowed to compete and the entry fees shall be refunded.

TITLES

There are three titles dogs may earn doing the Chase Ability Program. They are:

- Chase Ability (CA)

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges

- Chase Ability Excellent (CAX)

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of ten times (CA + 7 additional passes)

- Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2)

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc.)

COURSE LENGTHS OFFERED:

300 yards: For dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and/or brachycephalic (flat-faced) dogs.

600 yards: For all dogs not eligible to run the short distance.

If there is a question on which course a dog shall run the judge shall decide.

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog that achieves a PASS grade.

EQUIPMENT, FIELD CONDITIONS & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The field is a mown hay field, flat on the west side, sloping towards the road. A continuous loop system will be used for the Test. A drag system will be available for back-up.

- Dogs are requested to be present at roll call. They are free to leave after completion of their run(s).
- Handlers may use a slip lead when releasing their dogs. ALCA will have a limited number available for sale.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety.
- Dogs may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion.
- Retractable (Flexi type) leads and/shock collars are not permitted.
- The Chair may excuse any hound from competition for any reason deemed justifiable.
- A \$10.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for any dog loose on the field at any time between Roll Call and the completion of the last test.
- A \$10.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for anyone who does not clean up after their dog.
- There is limited shade and no water available, so please come PREPARED.

DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD

This field is north east of Sherwood Park. Shopping, gas & coffee are less than 10 min away.

From South: Hwy 21 north to Hwy 16.

East on Hwy 16 to Range Road 225 (approx. 2 km)

Turn left (north) on Range Road 225.

Field is 4 km north of Hwy 16 on left side of road. Entrance has SVTA in big letters over the gate.

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - INFO REGARDING TITLES

The following is quoted from the CKC website:

"The following non-member participation fee now applies and is retroactive to January 1, 2011.

The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members and a participating non-member can chose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

ATTENTION

The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
