Shannon Scheer and Alana Smith of Chilcotin Kennels will have the name the Best In Specialty winner engraved on the cup and present a prize to the winner. The Chilcotin Cup will be available for pictures but will remain in the possession of Shannon Sheer and Alana Smith.

The following information is for both Specialties.

Classes

Regular Classes:

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be offered at this Specialty:

6-9 months; for puppies 6 months of age but not exceeding 9 months of age.

9-12 months; for puppies 9 months of age and not exceeding 12 months of age.

12-15 months; for dogs of 12 months of age and not exceeding 15 months of age.

15-18 months; for dogs of 15 months of age and not exceeding 18 months of age.

Canadian Bred;(must have been bred in Canada)

Bred By Exhibitor; (must be Breeder, Owner/Co-Owner, Handled)

Open; shall be for any age. Please remember if a puppy to check off the puppy box on your entry form.

Veteran's Class: shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over. Dogs in this class do not compete for points; the winner of each class goes directly on to compete at the Best of Breed level. They may also be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only: shall be for dogs who have obtained the CKC requirements for Canadian Championship and contain a CKC Registration Number.

PLEASE NOTE: if competing for Best Bred By in Breed on a Specials Dog/Bitch, please check of the box on your entry form indicating you are Breeder/owner/handler.

Award Of Merit: At the conclusion of the Best of Breed competition the Clubs are offering Award Of Merit. One Award of Merit may be awarded for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed at the Judge's discretion.

Sexually Altered Classes: Two classes only will be offered - Altered Male and Altered Female

Non-Regular Classes: All dogs must be entered in the Regular classes, Veterans, Altered or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes.

Brace: Two dogs that look alike (either sex or mixed) shown on one lead, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Team: Four dogs that look alike (either sex or mixed) shown together, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Stud Dog & Get: Stud dog and TWO or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Brood bitch and TWO or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Parade Of Veterans: Open to dogs and bitches 7 years of age and over . No entry fee is charged for this event however the dogs must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only for the respective Specialty. Send resume and your Veteran's call name to the Show Secretary with your entries.

Sweepstakes

Juvenile Sweepstakes

Open to all Dachshund puppies over six months and under eighteen months of age who are entered in the regular official classes of the respective specialty show. Puppies will be divided by sex (not breed) as follows, 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18

For final judging, the first place winners from each class will be brought together to select the Best Puppy In Sweepstakes. The puppy placing second in the class to this puppy will return for selection of First Runner-up. Prizes

Best Puppy In Sweepstakes Rosette & 35% of the total entry fee

First Runner-up Rosette & 20 % of the total entry fee

Second Runner-up Rosette & 15 % of the total entry fee

Third Runner-up Rosette & 10 % of the total entry fee

1st in each Class Ribbon

20% of the total entry fee will be retained by the club for expenses.

Veteran Sweepstakes

Open to all Dachshunds over 7 yrs on the day of the Specialty who are entered in a regular class or exhibition only in the respective Specialty. Altered Veterans are eligible. The Veterans will be divided by sex (not breed) into the following classes. 7-9 yrs and 9 yrs & over

Prizes

Best Veteran In Sweepstakes ~ Rosette & 30 % of the total entry fee

Best Opposite In Sweepstakes ~ Rosette & 20 % of the total entry fee

1st In Class ~ Ribbon & 10 % of the total entry

Junior Handling

Junior handling will be offered at both specialties. Juniors must show a Dachshund in the specialties junior handling. Dogs partaking in juniors must be entered in the corresponding specialty in a regular class or Exhibition only.

Judges – TBA

Prizes – Rosettes & Prize for Best Overall and 1st in Classes.

Rosettes for 2nd, 3rd, & 4th in class.

Junior Handling Classes

All class ages are as of December 31st of the year proceeding the competition year.

Pee Wee – 4 years of age up to 6 years.

Junior Novice – This class is for handlers 7 to 10 years of age and who have not won 6 first places in this class.

Junior Open – 7 to 10 years of age and who have one 6 first places in the Junior Novice Class.

Intermediate Novice – This class is for handlers 11 to 14 years of age who have not won 6 first places in this class.

Intermediate Open – 11 to 14 years of age and who have one 6 first places in the Intermediate or Junior Novice Classes.

Senior Novice – This class is for handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years old and have not won 6 first places.

Senior Open – 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age and have won 6 first places in the Senior, Intermediate or Junior Novice classes.

Rules & Regulations

This specialty show is in conjunction with an all-breed show and there for the specialty will conform to their rules and regulations. Please see there premium list for further details.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Fax entries will be accepted. See instructions elsewhere in this premium list.
3. Post-dated cheques ARE NOT acceptable. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. **A \$35.00 SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL N.S.F. CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.**
4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
5. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing **MUST BE MADE IN WRITING** to the Show Secretary so as to be received **BEFORE SHOW CLOSING DATE.**
6. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or canceled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.
7. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be mailed or emailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address. All online and fax entries will receive a conformation email, this is your receipt for our shows.
8. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron. The Show Giving Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.
9. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
10. ACCORDING TO CITY BYLAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. **Anyone not following stop and scoop policy will be excused from the shows and trials.**

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
