Do you struggle with deciding if you should turn your dog to the left or to the right after a particular jump?

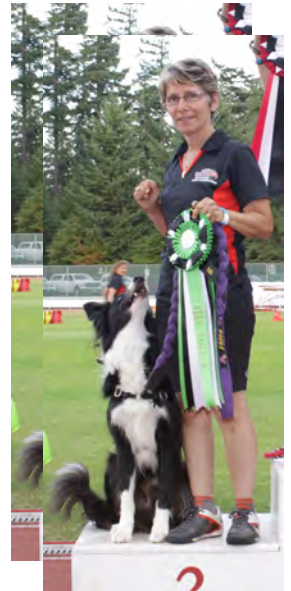
Are those decisions based on guesses rather than cold hard facts?

- The seminar begins with you walking and running a masters level course making all your own decisions (help will be provided if needed). Your course time will be recorded with electronic timing equipment.
- Next, we will walk the course together and discuss key sections on course where different handling options are possible.
- We will time you and your dog on different handling options on at least two 3-5 obstacle sections of the course so you can determine what will be your fastest option.
- Finally, you will run the entire course again using the new information, and your run will be timed.
- Each session is limited to 8 working spots.
