Rules

- Breeder enters three dogs from at least two different litters of the same breed (Champions can comprise any or all of the breeder's trio)
- All entered dogs must be over six months of age
- The entrant must be the breeder of record for all three dogs
- Breeder of record must be the first handler of the trio

Entry Fee:

\$10 for the first dog
 \$5 for each of the other dogs

**** One of the Dogs entered must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition only.****

Judging

All breeds of a group will be judged together. For example, the Sporting Group may have two trios of Golden Retrievers, three trios of Irish Setters and one trio of Sussex. Judges will evaluate the breeder's ability to consistently produce superior dogs of health, conformation and uniform type — consistent with the breeder's mission to improving their chosen breed.

- Competition begins at the group level
- Judges will evaluate the quality of the breeding program on the three exhibits
