ARM BAND NUMBERS AND CATALOGUES: Please pick your arm band numbers at the specialty ring.

WRISTBANDS: All exhibitors to pick up their wristbands at the AKC Show Desk beginning Thursday, July 29th. You will need a wristband to access the show site during the weekend. Please present your entry receipt to get a wristband. Receipts can be printed by going to www.thedogshow.ca website – choose My Account – the dogs you have entered in AKC and its associated specialties will be there.

ON ARRIVING: Please follow the signs to the exhibitors drop off area and parking.

DAY TENTING: You may drive into a designated parking area to unload between 6 and 8:00 a.m. and after show events have been completed. During show hours you will have to cart your equipment from the parking lot. ALL day tents must be dropped at night for safety.

SET-UP DAY: Thursday, July 29th, 2010, starting at 12:00 noon.

IN-DOOR BENCHING: Will now be in the “E” barn instead of the “K” barn and will be allowed in from 12:00 p.m. on Thursday. All stalls will be numbered – please check the list by the door for your number if someone is not there to help.

RV DRIVERS: Will be given a Vehicle Pass, which must be presented when you come and go from the field. All rigs must have boards placed under tires and generators.

Show site maps may be available on a limited basis at the show desk.

NON SMOKING: Spruce Meadows is a designated non-smoking area to keep everyone safe.
