GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Dartmouth Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of and accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
- 2. The building will be open an hour and a quarter before judging commences.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- 4. The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
- Due to the limited amount of space, the superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the superintendent in this regard.
- 6. No dogs will be allowed in the building overnight.
- In no case may a dog under 3 months of age be allowed within the show/trial precincts.
- 8. "Puppy/Dog for sale" signs will not be permitted within the precincts of the show.
- 9. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 10. Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted in the building.

- 11. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- 12. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/handler to clean up after their dogs outside the ring and outside the building. Please make sure your x-pen area is clean before you leave.
- 13. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the DKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- The Dartmouth Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

A class dog awarded best in show at an all breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.
