

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

PLEASE USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open

Veterans Specials Only Exhibition Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed..

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only,

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps is for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only but not Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months. Senior Class for dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months. 12-18 Open for dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

All class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first through fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

Veterans Sweeps is for any dog 7 yrs. of age and up. There will be 6 classes divided by sex:

9 – up to 12 years 7- up to 9 years 12 years of age and up

As in Puppy Sweeps the class winners will compete for Best in Sweeps . A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps & Best Opposite.

Division of the prize money in Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes will each be as follows:

25% of the total sweepstakes entry fees will be retained for administration.

15% of the total sweeps entry fees in each class will go to the Best in Sweeps.

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of that class

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 15

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Building will open at 6:30am each day. On Friday, the Building will be open from 4:00pm until 10:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.
- The Show Supt. will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- The MG7 Club and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The MG7 Club and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the MG7 Club and its Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.-
- All rules and regulations as outlined in the Halifax Kennel Club premium list apply to this event.
