Judging Order - TDX judging will follow the completion of all TD tracks. Bitches in season will be allowed to compete and will run last. Pinch or prong collars are not allowed on the Test grounds.

Rendezvous - Scheduled for 7:30 a.m. Sunday, October 3rd 2010 at Woodwynn Farm, 7789 West Saanich Road Victoria, B.C., where entrants will immediately draw lots for the order of the tracks. A no host lunch will follow. Confirmation of entry and directions to rendezvous point will be forwarded to each competitor upon receipt of entry.

Alternates - As of 1991, the C.K.C. has ruled that all Tracking Tests, having a limited entry, must accept alternates to their entry list. Entrants will be informed of their position on the alternate list immediately following the closing date of entries and will be informed of a cancellation up to I hour prior to the Test.
