# As per CKC Rules as of January 1, 2010 - A "RAMP" MAY BE USED FOR CERTAIN BREEDS " RAMP INFORMATION

As per CKC Rules effective January 1, 2010. At the discretion of the judge, designated ramp breeds. (See Appendix H for a list of Breed that may be judged on a ramp) may be examined on the ground or on a ramp. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner on the ramp or on the ground. 4.5.3 Breeds not designated as either table or ramp breeds are customarily examined on the ground. At the discretion of the judge, ramps may be used to judge any breed. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner.

#### SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Fax entries will be accepted. See instructions elsewhere in this premium list.
- 3. Post-dated cheques ARE NOT acceptable. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or Credit Cards in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A \$25.00 SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL N.S.F. CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.
- 4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
- 5. Obedience entry fees WILL gladly be refunded to exhibitors whose bitches are in season during our TRIALS and must be withdrawn, IF (a) a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the Trial, OR (b) the bitch is on hand for inspection in the show building prior to the Trial.
- 6. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but MUST BE FOLLOWED UP IN WRITING to the Show Secretary so as to be received no more than 7 days after closing.
- 7. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or canceled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.
- 8. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be mailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address.
- 9. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
- 10. A judge officiating at a show held under the Dog Show Rules shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.
- 11. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron. The Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.
- 12. Dogs will be allowed to stay in the building over-night, however, they will be left at the owner's /handler's own risk. There is no over-night security.
- 13. The show building will close at 11:00 PM and will open at 6:30 a.m. each day.
- 14. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 15. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
- 16. ACCORDING TO CITY BYLAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. Anyone not following stoop and scoop policy will be excused from the show.
