Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over, not for competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.

Dogs competing in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only. Get and Progeny must be entered in a Regular Class.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Dogs must be either registered with the C.K.C. or have an Event Registration Number (ERN). All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN.
