- Fire Lanes/Aisles must be kept clear.
- All dogs must be exercised in the exercise pens provided for that purpose. Exhibitors are liable for all costs related to cleaning or damage caused by a dog (s) under their control. Failure to exercise appropriate diligence may results is a loss of show privileges.
