

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following official classes are offered for both sexes:					
JUNIOR PUPPY	6 months but under 9 months				
SENIOR PUPPY	9 months but under 12 months				
12-18 MONTHS	12 months but under 18 months				
CANADIAN BRED	For dogs born in Canada, champions in any country are excluded.				
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	For dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.				
OPEN	For all dogs.				
VETERANS	For dogs 7 years of age or over as of the date of the show. These dogs will compete for regular placement and the first place dog will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans class will NOT compete for the points, but will go directly into Best of Breed competition.				
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for championship status.				

SEXUALLY ALTERED For all spayed or neutered dogs. Points can be earned towards and Altered Championship, although points may not be carried over from regular competition classes. This class held following the judging of Best of Breed and prior to any non-regular classes. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female

The following Non-Regular classes will be offered:

Dogs entered in the Non-Regular Classes must be entered in a regular specialty class or for exhibition only. Spayed/neutered dogs may be entered in non-regular classes but must be entered in Exhibition Only or in the official Veterans class.

Exhibition Only: All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class, but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

Stud Dog and Get: At least two get must accompany the Sire who is entered. The Sire will not be judged only the get.

Brood Bitch and Progeny: At least two progeny must accompany the Dam who is entered. The Dam will not be judged only the progeny.

Brace: For two dogs (not necessarily the same sex), the property of the same owner.

Juvenile Sweepstakes

As per CKC rules, all dogs in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes at this Speciality. The following classes will be offered divided by sex:

6 to 9 months 9 to 12 months 12 to 18 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Rosettes will be provided for First through Third place in each class. After 25% has been deducted for expenses, entry money will be divided as follows:

First in each class	25% of entry fee for that class.
Second in each class	10% of entry fee for that class.
Third in each class	5% of entry fee for that class.

Best in Sweepstakes - 20% and a rosette. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes - 15% and a rosette.

Veteran Sweepstakes

For dogs and bitches 7 years of age or over on the day of the Speciality. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular breed classes at this Speciality or for Exhibition Only. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Veterans' Sweepstakes provided they are also entered in Exhibition Only or the official Veterans class. The following classes will be offered, divided by sex:

7 to 9 years 9 to 11 years 11 years and older

Rosettes will be provided for First in each class. After 25% has been deducted for expenses, entry money will be divided as follows:

First in each class - 25% of entry fee for that class. Best in Veteran Sweepstakes - 50% and a rosette. Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes - 25% and a rosette.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: You are invited to send in a typed resume on the Veteran you are entering in this Sweepstakes. Resumes will be printed in a special 'Veterans' section of the catalogue.

NOTICE TO FOREIGN EXHIBITORS FROM THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number.

To obtain an ERN (Event Registration Number) simply do the following:

- 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number
- 2. Include payment of \$61.42 Canadian Dollars
- 3. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non CKC Members please note that if paying by cheques, the cheque must be certified.
- 4. Non-residents of Canada note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- 5. Provide your full return address.
- 6. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or MasterCard number is legible and you have to include your expiry date and signature.

An ERN number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension. Please forward your request to:

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points, and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below; **Breeds Competing GROUP 1st GROUP 2nd GROUP 3rd GROUP 4th**

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall **NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)
