N.S.F. Cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention Foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official CKC entry form. **Please type or print clearly.**
2. **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.** Agents and handlers please note that **full name and address of owners MUST** be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. **(Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)**
3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
4. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing time and date.
5. Only dogs entered may attend these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only on the day of the Sweepstakes. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.
Senior Class for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.
12-18 Open for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.
The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only on the day of the Sweepstakes. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 9 years for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years
9 up to 11 years for Dogs at least 9 years of age up to but not including 12 years
11 years of age and older for Dogs 12 years of age and older

For Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps
10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps
25% will be retained for administrative purposes
50% remaining of the entry fees for a class will go to the class winners

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Halifax Kennel Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
2. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over their children while they are on the show premises
3. The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these Shows.
4. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules)
5. No person may approach a judge directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Section 4.1.6, Dog Show Rules)
6. "Double Handling" will not be tolerated. The Superintendent reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing so to leave the building.
7. The building will close one half hour after the completion of daily judging.
8. Only dogs entered in the Shows will be allowed in the building.
9. "Puppy for Sale" and "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
10. The Halifax Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.
11. There will be no prong or spike collars or flexi leads permitted at this venue. Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated. There will be no excessive training or playing within 30 feet of the obedience ring.

12. BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring floors.
13. Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip, left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety by the appropriate authorities

Baby Puppy A dog 3 months up to 6 months on the day of the show
Junior Puppy A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor A dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Exhibition Only Dogs 6 months and over not in competition.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Mixed-breed and unrecognized-breed dogs (purebred from CKC recognized registries) may compete in Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials.

In order to compete in CKC trials, mixed-breed and unrecognized-breed dog owners must apply for a Canine Companion Number (CCN) prior to entering and meet specific criteria as set out in the Canine Companion Club Policy. Applications for a CCN number can be submitted to CKC.

Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B (Pre-Novice, Novice C and Novice Intermediate)

SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED State Jump Heights
Pre-Novice for all purebred dogs over 6 months of age.(Not eligible for HIT Competition)
"A" Classes for dogs handled by owner or immediate family member through all exercises.
"B" Classes for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Cdn. OTCh. degree or dogs who have earned titles in another country.
"C" Classes for dogs who have completed a C.D. title in Canada.(Not eligible for H.I.T.competition)
C.D.I. Class Novice -Intermediate, for dogs who have earned a C.D. title in Canada (Not eligible for H.I.T. Competition)
Open for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada.
Utility A for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D.in Canada.
Utility B for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in Canada
Exhibition Dogs 6 months & over, not in competition.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES Graduate Novice, Brace, Wild Card

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms

Novice A for dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Novice B For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.
Intermediate For any dog that has earned an RN title.
Advanced A for dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Advanced B For any dog that has earned the RN title
Excellent A for dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Excellent B For any dog that has earned the RA title

Unofficial Classes – Brace, Team

A Bitch in season **may not** compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees will be refunded **ONLY** if the Trial Secretary BEFORE commencement of the trial receives a Veterinarian’s Certificate.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN)

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog’s registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as “LISTED”, however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 1SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

Points allocated 0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded winners.

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.
