The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

Veteran Class will be divided as follows:

7 years up to 9 years, 9 years up to 12 years, 12 years and older

ATTENTION: A special Ribbon and prize will be awarded to the <u>OLDEST Veteran in</u> competition (not necessarily the Winning Veteran)

**Note:** Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

**Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs:** These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best of Altered In Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the Regular Classes

### **POINTS**

Chapter 20, Section 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show held under the CKC Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship Points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of Championship Points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of Championship Points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breeds awards Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set for above.comking

#### Non-Regular Classes

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes <u>must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials</u> Only or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class: shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only.

**Brood Bitch Class:** shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only.

Brace Class: shall be for two dogs of the same breed, colour and identical ownership

# Puppy Sweeps

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class: for Basenjis at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months
Senior Class: for Basenjis at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months
12-18 Open: for Basenjis at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best In Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth place in each class as well as to Best In Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in sweeps.

# Veteran Sweeps

Veteran Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 years up to 9 years: for Basenjis at least 7 yrs of age up to but not including 9 yrs 9 years up to 12 years: for Basenjis at least 9 yrs of age up to but not including 12 yrs

**12 years of age & older:** for Basenjis 12 years of age and older.

# **Sweepstakes Prize Distribution**

For both Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes the Class Winners will compete for Best In Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

# DOG SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

A copy of the CKC rules pertaining to Conformation Shows is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the CKC regarding their event.

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.3 states "a Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out'.

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.6 states "no person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action may be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act".

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Precincts of the show will be the Show Site and Entrance, within 30 feet of the rings.
   The show Superintendent will be in full charge of the Show,
- Unless officially entered, no dogs under 6 months of age are allowed with the Show Precincts.
- Your identification and Judging Schedule will be mailed as soon after closing as is possible.
