## **RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS**

1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
  2. A DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
  3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
  4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1-HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
  5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM ENTRY IS MADE
  6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
  7. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS
  8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
  9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
  10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.
- ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES.**

### CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, **SHALL** be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

## **AGREEMENT**

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Renaissance Dog Association, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

## **JUDGES BIO**

### **KARSTEN KAEMLING (Specialty judge)**

Mr. Karsten Kaemling, of Vancouver, British Columbia, is a Life Member of the Canadian Kennel Club and has been a licensed CKC Judge since 1999. Karsten is approved to judge the Terrier, Toy, Herding, Hound, and the Non-Sporting Groups with the CKC.

Apart from his assignments in Canada he has also judged in Germany, New Zealand, Russia, Australia and Ireland.

Karsten has bred and exhibited the Airedale Terrier and the Sealyham Terrier, along with the Afghan Hound. He is also the pioneer of the Cesky Terrier in Canada, having imported the breed, launching the national breed club, and eventually achieving full recognition for the breed with the CKC in the year 2000.

Karsten has written many articles which have been published internationally and has also given numerous seminars at judges' education study groups. He has served on the Canadian Kennel Club Registration Committee, and is currently serving on the Canadian Kennel Club Discipline Committee. Karsten has also participated as a mentor and instructor at dog handling classes especially geared towards the novice exhibitor.

## PUPPY & JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

### ELIGIBILITY

1. All Terrier puppies and juveniles, 6 months of age but less than 18 months of age on the day of the show shall be eligible to compete, regardless of place of birth. *Altered* dogs may not compete.
2. All dogs entered must be entered in one of the official breed classes in the Specialty.
3. Entrants MUST be **breeder, owner-handled or co-owner handled.**

### Classification

For the purpose of judging, the dogs will be divided by sex into the following class: *6 months & under 9 months, 9 months & under 12 months, 12 months & under 18 months.*

### PRIZE LIST

Class Placements – Flat ribbons and a prize will be offered for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in each class. There will be a rosette and suitable prize for Best of Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Division of prize monies: First place winners in each class will receive 10% of the total fees collected. Best in Sweepstakes will receive 15 % of the total fees collected and a suitable prize. To defray costs the club will retain the remaining 25% of the fees.

## Conformation Classifications

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

**JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog **6 months of age and under 9 months of age** on the day of the show

**SENIOR PUPPY CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog **9 months of age and under 12 months of age** on the day of the show

**12 to 18 MONTH CLASS** - For dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of this Specialty

**CANADIAN BRED CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.

**(Champions of any country excluded)**

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

**OPEN CLASS** - This class shall be for all dogs

**SPECIALS ONLY CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog, which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. **Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded**

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

## ADDITIONAL REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following additional regular classes will be offered at this Specialty:

**VETERANS CLASS** For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS (This class will be divided into 3 age divisions – 7 to 9 yrs, 10 & 11 yrs and 12+ yrs. Winners of each class will carry through to compete for Best of Breed) PLEASE NOTE: SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS MAY COMPETE IN THIS CLASS

Due to the anticipated large entry, the club is reserving a portion of the building for pre-assigned grooming spaces. Those exhibitors who are LISTED as EITHER THE OWNER OR THE HANDLER/AGENT on 6 or more dogs, or who are co-ordinating a group of individuals setting up together, may request that an area be reserved for them. Once the allotted area has been filled, all further requests will be returned as will any requests received after the close of entries for the all-breed show. Requests will be acknowledged via email after the closing date and prior to the beginning of the show.

**Please note: Exercise pens may be restricted to 1 pen per 3 entered dogs, depending on the size of the entry.**

In addition to the pre-assigned areas, there will also be regular first come, first served grooming space in which equipment/dogs may be left for the duration of the shows. Ex-pens are permitted in this area.

There will also be an area that will be set aside for Day of Show grooming - this will be first come, first served and all equipment MUST BE REMOVED after Best in Show each night. There will be NO exercise pens allowed in this area.

Any equipment left after Best In Show will be removed by the club or one of it's delegates.

Grooming areas will be monitored by the club and delegated individuals - and exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean, or abuse the space allotted may be asked to leave the show.
