The clinic will be held in a vet's office in Nanaimo on November 21<sup>st</sup>, *by appointment only*. Appointments will start approximately 1:00 pm. Samples will be shipped to Dr. Dodds office in California for diagnosis in her office using the most comprehensive diagnostic profiles for detecting and interpreting autoimmune thyroiditis and hypothyroidism, with reference ranges based on age, sex, breed and activity. # **DR. JEAN DODDS BLOOD TESTS AVAILABLE NOVEMBER 21, 2010**

## **THYROID 5 PROFILE PLUS**

Includes Thyroid 5 Profile plus CBC and Serum Chemistries (see below)

## **THYROID 5 PROFILE (T4, FreeT4, T3, FreeT3 + TgAA)**

Tests the overall thyroid function and identifies possible hypothyroidism or heritable thyroiditis. Signs of low thyroid function may be fatigue, dry skin and coat, behavioral issues, or excessive weight gain, as well as many other signs.

## **CBC, COMPLETE BLOOD COUNT with DIFFERENTIAL**

Measures the levels of different types of blood cells. By determining if there are too many or not enough of each blood cell type, a CBC can help to detect a wide variety of illnesses or signs of infections.

The differential portion of the CBC measures the amount of each type of white blood cell in the blood. It also reveals if there are any abnormal or immature cells.

## **SERUM CHEMISTRIES WITH CBC**

Measures the levels of serum proteins and electrolytes, such as sodium and potassium. This is typically ordered to look for any sign of kidney, liver, adrenal or pancreatic dysfunction. It also checks for diabetes, metabolic disorders, changes in albumin and globulins (antibodies), and tissue damage.

## **SERUM CHEMISTRIES WITHOUT CBC**

## **DISTEMPER, PARVOVIRUS VACCINE TITERS**

Vaccine titer tests check for the presence and strength of the immunological response to a viral disease. If the test reports back satisfactory levels the pet is considered sufficiently immune to the disease, or has a good "immunologic memory," and should not need further vaccination against the disease at that time.

## **RABIES VACCINE TITERS (not for export)**

Rabies vaccine titers measure the amount of rabies antibody present after rabies vaccinations. They typically are not accepted as an alternative to rabies booster regulatory requirements. Rabies titers may be accepted on a case-by-case basis with written veterinary medical justification for exemption. Check first with your veterinarian and local authorities.

## **HEARTWORM ANTIGEN**

A test that identifies microscopic pieces of heartworm protein circulating in a dog's bloodstream. A positive antigen test indicates canine heartworm infection.
