The Schedule:

This schedule was prepared as quickly as possible. Please allow for errors.

Building Hours:

The show building will be open for **exhibitor set-up from 6:00 pm to 10 pm on Thursday, July 22**nd . (**No early birds please**)

The building will be open each morning as follows:

Friday: 8:00 am; Saturday: 7:30 am; Sunday: 7:00 am and will close each night at 10 pm. There is NO security.

<u>INDOOR GROOMING & SET-UP</u>: In order to ensure that there is room & power for everyone, X-pens will not be allowed.

There is a 12' wide area in front of the obedience rings for the obedience exhibitors in which dryers will NOT be allowed!

Rings: Ring I is INside; Ring 2 is OUTside; Ring 3 is the Obedience Ring

<u>Outdoor Ring:</u> The outdoor ring is on a raised area. Pop-up shade tents will be allowed around the outside edge of the raised area. Areas for pop-up tents will be marked.

Ready Rings: Crates and x-pens may **NOT** be in the ready ring areas at **any** time. Grooming tables, wet towels etc being used in the ready ring MUST be removed immediately following completion of judging. Tables and towels left in the ready ring will be removed!

Crates and chairs will NOT be allowed under the outdoor ready ring marguis....this will be strictly enforced.

Arm Bands: Pick up armbands at the show secretary's desk.

The LKC armband is for all 3 shows plus sweeps. There is a separate arm band for the German Shepherd Specialty.

Non-Smoking Venue:

This is a non-smoking venue. There will be an ash can outside the big doors. Please don't leave cigarette butts on the ground.

Attention US Exhibitors: Both the American and Canadian immigration personnel have advised us that while there are no new rules regarding border crossing, terrorism concerns have made both sides more vigilant.

A Passport is now required to enter Canada & to return to the United States!

All dog food being brought into Canada MUST be in UNOPENED original bags, with a readable label of ingredients. If the original owner of the meat had a hoof....it probably will not be allowed! (i.e. beef, lamb, pork etc) Chicken is still good to go.

***A current Rabies certificate is required for each dog.

New Champions: If you finish your dog at LKC this weekend, see the show secretary to receive your "New Champion" souvenir from LKC.

Food & Refreshments: The "THIS OLD BARN" booth will be availabe from early morning to early afternoon.

<u>Camping</u>: Camping spots have been assigned and will be marked on **WEDNESDAY morning**.
