Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

# **NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT**

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members

#### **ENTRY INFORMATION:**

- All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- 3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show / trials secretary after the closing date and time.
- 6. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 7. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

**Attention USA exhibitors:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

#### SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW

**REGULAR CLASSES:** The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open Working Dog

Veterans Specials Only Exhibition Only

**Veterans class** will be divided into 7-10 years, 10-13 years, and 13 years plus

**Working Dog** For dogs that have attained a **CKC Earthdog Title**. These dogs do not compete for winners but the first place male/female from this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed

**Note:** At the judge's discretion, a prize and rosette may be offered for every ten dogs competing at the Best of Breed level. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed...

#### NONREGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in NonRegular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

**Baby Puppy Class** - Dogs 3 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non regular class.

**Brace Class** – shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed

**Stud Dog Class** shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

**Brood Bitch Class** shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

#### **UNOFFICIAL CLASSES:**

**Breeder's Class** – The breeder of record enters a team with a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 dogs, without distinction as to gender. The entrant must be the breeder of record for all exhibits. It is not required that the breeder be the current owner. All dogs entered must be a

minimum age of 6 months – spayed and neutered dogs are eligible. Breeders may enter more than one team. Each team will be judged as a unit, standing and moving to determine their overall quality, consistency and similarity. Breed type and conformation to the breed standard. Awards will be presented to Best Breeders Team and Reserve Best Breeders Team.

# Parade of Versatility Title Holders (POV)

Our very first Parade of Versatility Title holders will showcase the versatility of the Border Terrier. To be eligible for this event, a dog or bitch must have earned the BTC Versatility Title or Versatility Excellent Title and be owned or co-owned by a BTC member.

A commemorative item will be offered for Parade of Versatility Title Holders.

For information on qualifying for this title, go to the BTC website.

To be entered in the parade, a dog must be entered in a regular Specialty class or For Exhibition Only as well as the Parade of Versatility. Entry fee for the Parade of Versatility is \$15.

### **SWEEPSTAKES**

**Puppy Sweeps** is for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only but not Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

6-9 mo 9-12 mo 12-18 mo

All class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first through fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

**Veterans Sweeps** is for any dog 7 yrs. of age and up. There will be 6 classes divided by sex:

7- up to 10 years 10 – up to 13 years 13 years of age and up

As in Puppy Sweeps the class winners will compete for Best in Sweeps . A rosette will be awarded to first place in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps & Best Opposite.

Division of the prize money in Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes will each be as follows:

15% of the total sweeps entry fees in each class will go to the Best in Sweeps.

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of that class

25% of the total sweepstakes entry fees will be retained for administration.

#### **BEST OTTER HEAD**

Competition is open to any dog entered in the Specialty. Judge, Nancy Hogg will select which Border Terrier among those present, has the

most typical "Otter Head". A rosette and trophy will be awarded

# **JUNIOR HANDLING -** Friday, July 6

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only at the Border Terrier Canada Specialty. Entry to be made at the show. Complete rules will appear in the Show Catalogue. A prize and rosette will be awarded for Best Overall Junior Handler.

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st in each class.

#### THE ANNA FRASER MEMORIAL AWARD

The Anna Fraser Memorial Award is offered for the Best Working in Specialty in memory of founding member J. Anna Fraser for whom "essentially a working terrier" were more than just words in the standard.

To honour her passion, in 2016, friends of Anna donated 5 exquisite mugs made by her favourite Nova Scotia artisan, Deb Kuzyk of Lucky Rabbit Pottery, to be awarded at the next five Border Terrier Canada Specialties to Best Working.

This year, in recognition of the importance of those words in our standard, the Working Class will be an official class. This means that the winners of Working Dog and Working Bitch will compete for Best in Specialty along with the Specials, Veteran Winners, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch Following Best in Specialty, the winners of the Working Dog and Working Bitch classes will return to the ring to compete for Best Working unless it is automatic.

Because it is an official class, to be eligible dogs must hold a CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) Earthdog Title. Spayed bitches and neutered dogs may compete as long as they hold a qualifying title

Prizes will be awarded to every Border Terrier qualifying in the Cape Breton Kennel Club Rally and Obedience Trials July  $6^{th}$  thru July  $8^{th}$ , 2018

A prize will be offered to the Highest Scoring Border Terrier in the Cape Breton Kennel Club Rally Trial on Friday July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018

# **CATALOGUES**

A very limited number of catalogues will be available at the show at a cost of \$10.00 each. Catalogues will not be mailed to absent exhibitors or those who fail to pick up their pre-ordered ones during the show. Catalog advertising rate \$40.00 full page, \$25.00 half page

All copy must be print ready and in the hands of the show secretary, with payment, by entry closing date or they will not be printed. Ads may be in a Word document or as a jpg with a resolution of at least 240 dpi. Page size for the catalog is 5.5x8.5 inches

#### **REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.

- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$62.40 (plus GST or HST where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.

# Champions and championship points - chapter 15

**Section 1** - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

### Section 2:

Dogs competing	*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated		0	1	2	3	4	5

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Border Terrier Canada will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of and accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators
- 2. The building will be open an hour and a quarter before judging commences.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- 4. The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
- 5. Due to the limited amount of space, the superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to cooperate with the superintendent in this regard.
- 6. No dogs will be allowed in the building overnight.
- 7. In no case may a dog under 3 months of age be allowed within the show/trial precincts.
- 8. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 9. Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted in the building.
- 10. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- 11. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/handler to clean up after their dogs outside the ring and outside the building. Please make sure your x-pen area is clean before you leave.
- 12. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the CBKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials. no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 13. The Cape Breton Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.

#### **BORDER TERRIER CANADA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY**

(Adapted With Permission From The Border Terrier Club Of America Room Policy)

Border Terrier Canada (BTC) has adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future:

Any individual attending a Border Terrier Canada (BTC) sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTC Board of Directors.

- 1. May be banned from showing at the next BTC sanctioned event(s).
- 2. May be subject to CKC sanctions.
- 3. Membership in the BTC may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated. Damages shall be defined as:
- 1. Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/ campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).
- 2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
- 3. Any verified complaint by a BTC member.

# **BTC Room Regulations:**

- 1. All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/ handler must stay in the room with the dog.
- 2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel or campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
