<u>Temporary Competition # (TCN)</u> (<i>Replaced Listing</i>)	TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). The current TCN fee is \$10.50 per dog/day). https://www.ckc.ca/en/News/2021/March/TCNs-What-Are-They-And-How-Do-You-Get-One		
Event Registration Number:	All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation.		
Non-Member Participation Fee:	a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.		
	b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.		
	c) The Premium List must state "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".
