

DOG SHOW CLASS INFORMATION

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of this Specialty

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of this Specialty

12 to 18 Months Class – This class shall be for dogs at least 12 mos. of age on the day of this Specialty and under 18 mos. on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

VETERANS CLASS – This class shall be for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of this Specialty

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for Champions of record at the time of closing of entries for this Specialty. **Note:** A Listed dog *MAY* be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class *MUST* be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FIRST SHOW. Listing Fees *WILL NOT* be refunded

NON-REGULAR CLASSES: Brace, Brood Bitch and Progeny, Stud Dog and Get, EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades DOGS ENTERED IN NON-REGULAR CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY

All dogs six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age shall be eligible to compete All dogs must be entered in one of the regular Breed classes and owner handled.

The classes in the Sweepstakes are divided by sex and offered as follows:

Junior Puppy 6 months and less than 9 months
Senior Puppy 9 months and less than 12 months
12-15 Months 12 months and less than 15 months
15-18 Months 15 months and less than 18 months

For final judging, the first place dog from each of the above classes will be brought together for the final placing of "Best in Sweepstakes" and "Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes"

PRIZES

Rosette.

Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 25% of the Entry Fees received and a Rosette Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 20% of the Entry Fees received and a

First Place winners in each class 3.75% of total entry and a Rosette 2nd to 4th place in each class—Flat Ribbon

The Club will retain the remaining 25% to defray costs.

Non Member Participation Fee

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a **Canadian** non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.



CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog.

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points ranging from 0 to 5, the number of championship points shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A Dog may not be credited with more than 5 points in a single show.

Entries will be accepted at the Show Secretary's Desk up to 1:00 pm on Saturday: FREE

- **4.1 Conformation Class Structure** Classes in Junior Conformation Handling competition shall be divided by age as follows:
- (a) **Pee Wee Class** This class is for handlers 4 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 7th birthday. This class is optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded; only participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.
- (b) **Junior Novice Class** This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date their 11th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.
- (c) **Junior Open Class** This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition.
- (d) **Intermediate Novice Class** This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.
- (e) **Intermediate Open Class** This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.
- (f) **Senior Novice Class** This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.
- (g) **Senior Open Class** This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Notice to CKC Clubs & Junior Handlers Re: Junior Handler Numbers

Please note that effective January 1, 2016, in accordance with Section 3.4.1 of the Junior Handling Rules & Regulations, Junior Handlers will be required to apply to CKC Head Office for a Junior Handling Number.

Chapter 3
GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS
Section 3.4 Entries

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

The Application For Junior Handler Number is posted on the CKC website under the Events tab, and then Under Event Forms, Exhibitor, or Event Supplies, Junior Handling. The application can be mailed, faxed, or e-mailed to CKC Head Office and there is no fee.

ADDITIONAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

- The Club reserves the right to remove any person from these shows, which will be held strictly under Canadian Kennel Club Rules.
- The Club reserves the right to decline to accept entries for just cause, in which case the fee will be refunded with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club holding the show or any official connected therewith for refusal of an entry.
- The Show-giving Club will exercise due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds. Exhibitors are responsible for their equipment and possessions.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. The club will not be responsible for and not obligated to
 provide any service for notifying owners or agent of breed or class judging. NO RING WILL
 BE HELD UP WAITING FOR EXHIBITORS OR HANDLERS.
- 6. For the benefit of the health of animals, the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping the show grounds as clean as possible. EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS. Dogs are to be exercised in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. Failure to comply may result in future entries being refused.
- All trailers, motor homes, campers and recreational units will have buckets underneath their sink drains. Anyone found discharging gray or black water from their unit will immediately be removed from the grounds.
- 8. There will be no other facilities in case of inclement weather.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- Entries will be acknowledged (with a judging schedule) as soon as possible after the closing date by email only. If it is not received within a reasonable time please contact the Show Secretary.
- 11. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Any exhibitor wishing to substitute or cancel an entry must do so in writing before the hour of closing. Substitutions or cancellations of entries after the closing time are prohibited. THERE WILL BE NO REFUND FOR OVERPAYMENT OR DUPLICATE ENTRIES..
- All Exhibitors are encourage to review the Canadian Kennel Club rule book at http://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/Conformation-Show-Rules-and-Regulations
- 13. Dogs must be kept ON LEAD in all Public Areas.
- 14. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 15. This is a Non Smoking Show.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will beaccepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. **Entries positively close 11:59 pm, PDT July 10, 2019** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- **6.** Judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- 7. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. or returned item will be subject to a minimum \$50.00 service charge.
 \$50.00 will be charged on all returned items NSF cheques.
