Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

**Barbara Hollings Memorial Trophy** awarded to Best Puppy ... Barbara was a second generation Cairn breeder, becoming involved in her teenage years. She was an active member of The Cairn Terrier Club while in England. She moved to Canada in 1965 bringing Oona of Highhedges with her to continue with her breeding. She was one of the founding members of the CTCC. Many of the breeders today started with foundation stock from Barbara's line.
