Notice To All Canadian Residents Only New CKC Rule

Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Prize List

Rosettes will be offered each day as follows;

Best In Show, Best Puppy In Show, First In Group, Best Puppy in Group. As well as Best Brace in Group and Show (Saturday Only)

Rosettes will be offered for 2nd, 3rd and 4th Group placements Best Altered in Show and 1st to 4th in Altered Group

*****ALTERED CLASSES******

LKC is pleased to have been granted permission by the CKC to offer ALTERED classes each day. Altered classes are for all dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Dogs will be judged exactly the same as in the regular show, with awards for Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Group placements 1st to 4th, and Best Altered in Show.

A rosette is offered for Group placements and Best Altered in Show.

(The point system to obtain an Altered Championship is the same as for the regular show.)

*****VETERAN CLASS*****

LKC is pleased to have been granted permission by the CKC to offer a VETERAN class each day. This class is for dogs over 7 years of age on the day of the show. Dogs may be spayed/neutered. Veteran males are judged immediately after the awarding of winners male and veteran females are judged immediately after the awarding of winners female.

Junior Handling Extravaganza

(Junior Handling Competition each day - open to ALL juniors)

LKC is pleased to present its 15th Annual Junior Handling Extravaganza! There will be a regular competition each day, with an award for the 3-day Best Overall

Aggregate Score; Runner-Up; and Best Overall Aggregate Score for a LKC Junior Member and Runner-Up.

A perpetual Memorial Trophy for both Top Aggregate Score, and Top Aggregate Score for a LKC Junior Member is offered in

memory of Siberian Husky, Champion Kee-Tuk-Ka's Kyana.

The following point system is NOT part of the official points awarded by the Canadian Kennel Club in the regular competition being held each day, but are being used ONLY to calculate scores to determine the winners of the Aggregate awards:

Best Overall

1st in class 100 points plus 10 points for every competitor defeated 2nd in class 75 points plus 10 points for every competitor defeated. 3rd in class 50 points plus 10 points for every competitor defeated 4th in class 25 points plus 10 points for every competitor defeated. Judges will be announced in the judging schedule.

The classes will be judged as part of the regular show, at various times thoughout the day. Presentation of the Top Aggregate Score winners will be just prior to Best In Show on Sunday.

Notice To All Foreign Exhibitors

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering C.K.C. events will no longer require a C.K.C. registration number, but will require an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This ERN does not register a dog with the C.K.C. for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the C.K.C. Each dog must have its own number. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request to the CKC for an extension.

Points Are Not Awarded to Incorrect or Incomplete Entries

- When a dog is co-owned, the names of all owners must appear on the entry form.
- Enter the dog under its registered name, not its call name or another dog's name. The only exception is with listed dogs where the name may change upon registration.
- A foreign dog registered in another country must be entered under its registered name in the country of origin.
- All entry forms must be legible type or print the information.
- NEW RULE: Section 8.2.5 Dog Show Rules: Effective Jan 1/06, an error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Chapter 20: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Section 4. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition as provided in Chapter 4, Section 8(j) of these Rules shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the Shows and Specialty Shows, which shall be governed by the Canadian Kennel Club Rules.

Print your entries carefully. Include your complete address. Errors made on entries by exhibitors or their agent must stand regardless of how or by whom entries were made.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee. No refund of entry fees will be made if it is impossible to open or complete any show because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of The Lakehead Kennel Club.

Entry fees will not be refunded should the dog be absent, sick, lame, in season, or excused by a Veterinarian, the Judge, or the Show Superintendent.

The Lakehead Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to Canadian Kennel Club Rules. Dogs must be ready for judging; individual dogs will not be called. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a Breed or Group. Dogs not entered in the Show are not allowed in the Building.

Exercise areas must be used. The Show Committee will take all precautions and use all methods to keep the Building and surrounding area as clean as possible. Exhibitors are expected to do their part as well. Due to limited space, private exercise pens will NOT be permitted

Lakehead Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors shall exercise control and restraint over their children while attending these shows.
