Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

At the discretion of the judge, an **AWARD OF MERIT** may be given for every ten (10) dogs competing for Best of Breed.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Sexually Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female.

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first-place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second-place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

BEST OWNER-HANDLED

The handler of the dog must be the owner of record or a direct family member. The owner-handler must show the dog at all levels of competition. Owner-handled competition is an unofficial award and there are no additional fees. Participants must be entered in a regular conformation class and the status as an Owner-Handled entry must be made in the appropriate box on the entry form.

REGULAR CLASSES

The following CKC classes (divided by sex; except Specials Only) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.
12-18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs divided by variety: short hair and long hair
FIELD CLASS	Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging and the winners in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered
VETERAN CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs will compete for regular class placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered. Class will be divided as follows: 7 - under 9 years, 9 years and older.
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES/UNOFFICIAL

All dogs must be entered in the Regular Classes or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following Non-Regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

SWEEPSTAKES

To enter Sweepstakes the dog must be entered in one of the regular classes on the day of Sweepstakes. Entry in Sweepstakes from the Exhibition Only class is not allowed - EXCEPT for puppies aged 3-6 months. These puppies may enter from the Baby Puppy Class or from the Exhibition (3-6 mos.) Class.

The winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in both Sweepstakes.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

The following Classes will be offered (divided by sex):

3 - 6 months 6 - 9 months 9 - 12 months 12 - 18 months

25% of the entry fees shall be retained by the club for expenses, with the remaining entry money divided as follows:

1st in each class 20% of remaining class entry fee;

Best Juvenile in Sweeps 70% of remaining Juvenile sweeps entry;

BOS Juvenile in Sweeps 30% of remaining Juvenile sweeps entry

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The following Classes will be offered (divided by sex):

7-9 years 9 years and over

25% of the entry fees shall be retained by the club for expenses, with the remaining entry money divided as follows:

1st in each class 20% of remaining class entry fee;

Best Veteran in Sweeps 70% of remaining Veteran sweeps entry;

BOS Veteran in Sweeps 30% of remaining Veteran sweeps entry

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Conformation Show Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club or can be viewed online.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club Premium List, will also apply to this Specialty.
- 3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Event Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" - Conformation Show Rules and Regulations - Section 19.7.
- 5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIAN EXHIBITORS!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms can be downloaded here. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS!

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to vou. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded here.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*} includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **no**t be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

- (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch).
- (b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.
