Takhini Fenced Training Field (Behind Takhini Arena, Range Road, Whitehorse, YT)

FACILITATOR: Pierre Lalonde

A promoter of positive reinforcement training methods, Pierre became an agility judge for the Agility Association of Canada (AAC) in 1996 and with the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) in 2001. He is also a CKC obedience judge and Rally Obedience judge. Pierre has judged dogs across the country in Local, Regional, National and Specialty Competitions. Over the past three decades, he has assisted in running trials, instructed Obedience, Rally O and Agility at all levels. He competively trains and shows his dogs, achieving numerous titles including CD, CDX, OTCH, CGC, Masters Snooker Dog of Canada and Master Jumpers Dog of Canada. Pierre is currently the Vice-President of the AAC as well as a Course Approver, an Examining judge and a member of the AAC Equipment Committee. Pierre has worked with his wife and fellow judge, Laurie Keith, in inspecting equipment and venues for the AAC and CKC. Over the past 4 years they have developed the Manitoba Agility League which promotes agility to new handlers and their dogs.

Workshop will include instruction in the types of CKC agility classes, completing SANCTION/TRIAL entry forms and CKC rules including new additions. CKC Agility Rule books will be included in registration for Working Spot participants and available to others at the Show &/or Workshop @ \$6.00 each.

Working Spots will include morning instruction and registration in afternoon sanction match and is limited to 10 participants (1 working dog per paid Working Spot). Dogs entered in Working Spots must have CKC registration number or be eligible for CKC registration and be at least 12 months of age on the day of the workshop. Ribbons will be provided to qualifying dogs as per CKC Agility Rules for Sanction Matches. Cost: \$100.00 per participant/1 dog.

Auditing Spots will include morning instruction and is limited to 10 participants. Auditors may observe during the match. Cost: \$60.00 per participant. No dogs please.

There will also be **FIVE (5) FREE AUDITING Spots** for participants willing to volunteer as Stewards as per follows:

Scribe (1), Table Steward (2), Timekeeper (1) Gate Steward (1). If you are interested in a Steward position please email Bonnitta Ritchie at sundogshows@live.com May 21st, 2014. All participants are expected to assist with moving equipment, etc. Participants are asked to bring their own lunch/crates/dog dishes, etc.
