CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB-SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15 – Champions and Championship points

SECTION 1 A dog awarded winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 1 to 5) and the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded Winner shall be as follows:

Dogs competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13+ Points Allocated 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges and must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

NOTICE TO U.S. EXHIBITORS RE: ERN NUMBERS

Dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or Visa/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$59.40 + 5% GST. payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES BY U.S. EXHIBITORS: Current exchange rate favors the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they must be payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds, or 'at par' as such items are not readily cleared through the banks. Your cooperation is appreciated!

INFORMATION FOR US EXHIBITORS ON ENTERING CANADA

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee
 reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and
 format as those included or they will be rejected.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries will not be accepted.
- 3. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone but MUST BE FOLLOWED UP IN WRITING to the Show Secretary so as to be received not more than 7 days after closing. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
- The entry of any dog cannot be altered or cancelled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules
- 5. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be mailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address.
- 6. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.
- Exhibitors are to pick up after their dogs both inside and outside of the show building; any exhibitor not doing so will be removed from the show.
- 8. No dogs are allowed to run loose any time

Regular/Non-Regular Classes Judge: ROBERT ENNIS

BABY PUPPY – dogs between 3 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Winners of this class do not compete for points. Baby puppy will be divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

The following Regular classes will be divided by sex:

JUNIOR PUPPY – dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show

SENIOR PUPPY – dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show

12-18 MONTHS – dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show

CANADIAN BRED – dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this

class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – for all dogs

VETERAN CLASS – for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs will

compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for

Best of Breed. Dogs competing in the Veteran Class may be spayed/neutered. SPECIALS ONLY – dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration

Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female:

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

(Dogs must also be entered in a regular class or exhibition only)

Exhibition Only: Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.

Strip Down: Shall be offered for any CKC registered American Cocker Spaniel of any age over 6 months (including neutered or spayed dogs). Length of hair is required to be trimmed to a maximum length of 1 ½ inches long on any portion of the body, with the exception of the ears where no length restrictions apply. Entrants are to be judged on conformation. All males will be judged first as one class, and then all bitches will be judged as the second class. The winners of these two respective classes will compete for Best in Stripped Down. Entrants must be entered in a Regular Class in the Specialty, Obedience Trial or Agility, or Exhibition Only to compete in the Stripped Down.

Stud Dog & Get: for a stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: for a dam and 2 or more of her progeny. Same rules as Sire & Get.

Brace: for 2 dogs of the same breed, not necessarily of the same sex and not necessarily by the same owner. Judged as an identical pair – same color, size, gait, and same stride. Must be handled by one person on one lead

<u>3-Generation:</u> This class entry is to be made up of a minimum of three generations, each descended from the one above. (i.e., Dogs A, B & C--A is sire or dam of B who is sire or dam of C.) Only one representative from each generation is allowed. Dogs must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only. Judge's decision is based on the consistency maintained through multiple generations in a breeding program. Dog A (the grandparent) is the dog entered. First Place only will be awarded in this class. Dogs do not need to be owned or bred by same person. Winner of class is Dog A.

Parade of Title Holders: for CKC registered American Cocker Spaniels who have received any title (conformation, obedience, agility, and field) in their respective country of ownership. Each titleholder will receive a Rosette with the dog's name imprinted in gold. Entrants must be entered in the Regular Classes or Exhibition Only in the Specialty. Please send a short printed bio (75 words or less) of your

<u>Parade of Veterans</u>: for CKC registered American Cocker Spaniels over the age of 7 years. Each veteran will receive a Rosette with the dog's name imprinted in gold. Entrants must be entered in the Regular Classes or Exhibition Only in the Specialty. Bio to callackr@telusplanet.net
