

29.e General Class Information

1) The day prior to the first day of the show shall be the date used to determine the age of the dog and the appropriate class.

2) Proof of registration must be submitted with each entry form to be accepted.

3) Proof of working titles (minimum of IPO 1 or equivalent) from a recognized organization's scorebook must be submitted with the entry form for the Working classes.

4) When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry with the exception of puppies and youth dogs as they must enter in the appropriate age class.

5) With the exception of the Kennel Group, Brood Bitch, Stud Dog and Exhibition classes, all other classes shall be divided into Males and Females.

6) Each day, all male classes exhibit first followed by all female classes **Puppy Classes**

4-6 Month Male/Female; 6-9 Month Male/Female;

Youth Classes: 9-15 Month Male/Female; 12-18 Month Male/Female Adult Classes

Intermediate 15-24 month Male/Female

Open Male/Female: 24 months and older <u>without</u> an IPO or a Championship title. **Champion Class** - **Over 15 months** with a Championship title from RKNA, AKC, CKC, International FCI Champions and any Champion of Record,

Copies of Championship **must** be submitted with the entry and originals **must** be made available at the show.

Working Male/Female: 18 months & older with an IPO title.

Copy of IPO title **must** be submitted with the entry and originals **must** be made available at the show.

Veteran Male/Female: 8 years or older the day of the show.

Brood Bitch: Entered by the owner of the brood bitch. Must have at least two (2) offspring appear in the ring. Offspring must be entered in regular classes. The class is evaluated on the merits of the offspring. Owner of the brood bitch does not need to be the owner of the offspring.

Stud Dog: Entered by the owner of the stud dog. Must have at least two (2) offspring appear in the ring. Offspring must be entered in regular classes. The class is evaluated on the merits of the offspring. Owner of the stud dog does not need to be the owner of the offspring

Kennel Class: Entered by the kennel owner. Three (3) or more dogs bred by the kennel owner and registered with the kennel name of the entrant. All dogs must be entered in the show's regular classes. The kennel owner need not be the owner of all the dogs.

Exhibition Class: Exhibition Classes are for critique only. This class is open to Rottweilers with a disqualifying fault or who are spayed or neutered. No ratings or placements are to be awarded. Dogs are critiqued with fault(s) noted. This class is for educational purposes only.

IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION

- Dogs born in countries with anti-docking laws must be shown with a natural tail.
- Copies of required documentation for the Champion and Working Classes must be submitted with entry and originals must be brought to the show and be available for inspection before entering the ring.
- Spayed or neutered dogs may not show with the exceptions of Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Classes.
- Dogs with missing teeth will be excused from the ring
- Males will be judged first
- All dogs must be shown on a Fur-Saver collar (no nylon or pinch collars nor choke chains)
- Dogs are shown in natural stance; no hand stacking is allowed. No food is allowed in the ring or as bait; toys may be used at the judge's discretion. Double handling is encouraged.
- Any entry that does not meet the Class requirement will be invalid.
- The host club shall not permit entry into any class if an entered dog's original registration and support documents of all certifications, accomplishments and titles are not available at the show for inspection at the time of the class.
- When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry.
- This is a German style Sieger show
- The event is being held outdoors, rain or shine
- No dogs are allowed to be tied out at the show site or ringside
- No dogs are allowed to be crated near the ring
- Please use designated areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them
- Adult classes will be moved long enough for the judge to evaluate the movement
- •Your dog should know to show bite; sides, front and open wide.
- •The dog must allow the judge to touch genitals and tail while standing.
