LIMITED ENTRY

Competitors may enter both agility and rally obedience. This is your chance to try rally if you've always wondered what the fuss is all about! Prenovice runs will include detailed briefing so even those who have never trained in rally can have success!

THIS IS A FUN MATCH: Toys, treats, clickers, and collars/leashes are all permitted on course for any run at any level. All levels can be entered by any competitor.

RIBBONS AND PRIZES: Will be given for 1st to 3rd place in each category. There will be "special" prizes for top scores, High in Class (rally) and judge's sportsmanship picks..

FOOD: Lunch included when five or more runs (mix and match) are purchased. Lunch of pizza, drinks and dessert may also be purchased separately for \$7.00. Coffee, tea and hot chocolate as well as a few snacks will be provided in the am.

Rally Classes:

<u>Pre-novice</u> A very simple novice course that people who have never competed in rally can complete. Includes in-depth briefing of exercises by judge before each class. Good "warmup" to regular novice courses for rally students. Performed on-leash.

<u>Novice</u> Includes all allowed novice exercises and consistent with difficulty one would see at a regular rally trial at the novice level. Performed on-leash.

Advanced/Excellent Includes a greater range of rally exercises/greater difficulty and performed off- leash in a regular trial.

Agilty Classes:

Gamblers: Consists of two distinct parts. In the first part, the dogs earns points

for each obstacle performed correctly (each obstacle may be performed twice successfully). After the whistle blows, the dog can earn bonus points by working away from the handler through a series of obstacles, while the handler stands behind a designated line.

Standard: Includes all obstacles and obstacles must be performed in order and in the time set by the judge

Jumpers Jumpers is a numbered course consisting of only jumps and tunnels.

Snooker: Two part course, opening consists of 3-4 red jump and obstacle combos, closing is numbered sequence of obstacles, 60 seconds.

SITE ETIQUETTE:

All competitors are required to clean up after their dog. Anyone failing to do so, will be dismissed from the competition with no refund.

When not competing, dogs are required to be on-leash—a crate or expen is strongly recommended. There will be a crating area provided. Car crating will depend on weather (heat).

Bring your own chair, please. Dress warmly, the barn is not heated.

No choke chains, pinch collars allowed on site. Flat collars, agility leashes or gentle leader type head harnesses/Sensi harnesses only. No electronic collars of any type.

Bright ribbons will be provided to dogs with "space issues" (reactive to other dogs) so others will be aware to not crowd them.

Further Rally Info

This event is being run under CARO rules and regulations. CARO is open to all dogs at least six (6) months of age, including purebred and mixed breeds, except bitches in

season or dogs with injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.

The trial will be run in accordance with CARO rules and regulations – the judge will explain the rules for the event during the judges briefing held immediately before it.

There will be qualifying ribbons awarded to each dog/handler team who achieves a score of 170 or better, you will also receive your dog's score card for each run you perform.

A "Highest Qualifier in Class" rosette will also be offered at the completion of judging.

Physically challenged handlers and dogs are encouraged to participate.

Dogs can be shown on a flat buckle, snap collar or plain harness. No choke, martingale, prong or shock collars, head halters or no-pull harnesses are allowed.

Leashes should be made of fabric or leather and be long enough to provide adequate slack. Dogs at the advanced or excellent level are not required to compete with a collar.
