VENUE INFORMATION: This is to be held outdoors, rain or shine. The Sprinter track has short grass footing with a slight uphill grade and will have a temporary fenced perimeter. Track inside fully fenced field.

Permission has been granted by the Canadian Kennel Club for holding these events under the Rules and Regulations of the CKC, Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. No entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries, except for as provided in the rules. These events are held under the rules of the "Canadian Kennel Club".

DAY OF TEST(S)

NOTE: Events will be afternoon/ early evening only NO Morning times

When you enter, you will be assigned to a one-hour time block (2pm, 3pm or 4pm for example). Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your time block. Once your dog has been inspected, you will be placed on the running order. Please ensure that your catcher is in place before you come to the start line. After your run, stop by the secretary to pick up your run time and ribbon. If you are entered in both events, after your first run, please return to inspection to be inspected and placed on the running order for your next runs.

You will receive your time block a few days before the event, after entries are closed.

Entries Open Monday June 15th , 2026

Entries Close: Friday July 3rd, 2026 or when limits are reached

Open to all dogs, mixed and unrecognized breeds over 1 year of age, that are individually registered with the CKC; or have Temporary Competition Number (TCN); or have a Performance Event Number (PEN); or eligible for registration with the CKC; or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.

NOTE : You must sign and submit BOTH the entry form and the waiver to be a valid entry.

CONDITIONS

- Perimeter Field is fully fenced
- **Each dog needs two handlers – one to release and one to catch. • All dogs will run individually.**
- All dogs must be inspected before each run – dogs found to be lame or unfit will be scratched and entry fee refunded.
- Dogs must be present at roll call for your time block. Dogs not present at roll call will be scratched and entry fee not refunded.
- Slip leads are recommended, and muzzles are optional
- **Retractable (Flexi type) leads and/shock collars are not permitted.**
- Dogs may wear a flat collar with no tags (or with tags taped up)
- NEW* Females in season must wear a clean, dry, snugly fitting panties specifically designed for the purpose of preventing/containing discharge. Females in season will be scheduled last

in the day – please notify the secretary in advance. Females in season must wear panties on the grounds, except in the designated potty area.

- A \$20.00 fine, payable to GLAWC, will be levied for any dog loose on the field at any time between Handlers briefing and the completion of the last test/event.
- Portable toilets will be available. • GLAWC, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children or spectators

NOTE:

1) (Listing) Fee of \$11.30 per dog is payable for each dog that does NOT have a CKC Registration Number, Performance Event Number or Event Registration Number, Temporary Competition number. This \$11.30 is in addition to the regular class entry fee. CKC has a Non-Member Participation Fee of \$170 +HST. This fee only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members. LIABILITY AGREEMENT I (we) acknowledge that the GREAT LAKES to ATLANTIC WHIPPET CLUB have the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this sprinter event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this sprinter trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agent, or any other persons.

THE ABOVE LIABILITY AGREEMENT AND DISCLAIMERS MUST BE AGREED TO BY ENTERING THIS TRIAL. BY ENTERING, YOU AGREE THAT YOU UNDERSTAND THE CKC SPRINTER TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

EQUIPMENT-A battery powered continuous loop system will be used. The sprinter area will be fully fenced with temporary snow fencing, including the 'catch pen' at the end of the track. Two stop watches will be used for timing and the average of the two will be entered.

- DAY OF TEST- When you arrive, your dog will be inspected, and you will be placed on the running order. Please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to the start time to accommodate this. Please ensure that your catcher is in place before you come to the start line. After all the runs are complete, the secretary will provide your run time and a ribbon. If you are entered in both events on the same day, please return to inspection to be inspected and placed on the running order for your second run. There is a large area available to cool down your dogs after a run.

AWARDS- Flat ribbons will be given for all qualifying runs. Limited Rosettes are available for new titles.

INDIGNITIES- It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Sprinter Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION: Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable about and will comply with the current CKC Sprinter Rules and Regulations. A copy may be obtained by calling the Central Order Desk of CKC at 1-800-250-8040 or by following this link: <https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows/Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/Sprinter-rules-regulations-January-2024.aspx>. All particulars called for on the entry form must be complete: Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog(s) regardless of how or by whom the entries were made— no refunds are given due to an error in entries. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full entry fees. The club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.

REFUNDS: There are NO credits nor refunds for anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date. Lameness dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded with a 30% processing fee deducted, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call. If the dog is not present for assessment, a note signed by a veterinarian will be required for any refund or credit consideration.

INJURED DOGS: If a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured within the 3 days preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The SCOC will be keeping 20% service fee and any TCN fees collected (if applicable)

VOLUNTEERS: They are essential to help run these events, so we can all enjoy our dogs having fun. Please consider volunteering at these events, learn to work as a starter, timer, begin learning about lure operating or helping other exhibitors with releasing or catching. You must let us know ahead of time. Thank every volunteer!

PLEASE CONSIDER VOLUNTEERING FOR AN HOUR BEFORE OR AFTER YOUR DESIGNED TIME

Positions available are - - - Inspection committee, Starter, Timers

Important SPRINTER rules:

The releaser must be capable of safely holding and releasing the dog. If someone has a disability, they can be the releaser but that must be disclosed so we can put a volunteer with that releaser to ensure the safety of the person and dog. We can only accommodate a couple of people for this at each trial and it must be disclosed in the entry form. If the wrangler, start line gate person or starter determines that the releaser or dog or other dogs are in danger due to the person's ability to release or dog's state of arousal during the trial the STARTER may either request a trained trial volunteer to release the dog or dismiss the dog from the trial without refund.

Do not let your dogs react to other dogs and the lure equipment when it is not his/her turn. This prevents others from fully enjoying the trial experience and our neighbours do not appreciate it.

All competitors MUST bring 2 leashes, one for the releaser and one for the catcher. There will be no extra leashes or handlers available. The dog owner is responsible for ensuring that their second person is present at the event on time. We cannot wait for any missing humans.

You cannot release or catch a dog with shoes showing any exposed skin. Shoes must cover the entire foot or you will NOT be able to run your dog. There will be NO refunds for this.

When a dog runs on the sprinter track, he/she must wear a flat collar with no tags. No harnesses, slip leads or martingale collars can be left on a dog when they run.

HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: ●Is known to have or has been housed with or is recovering from (30 days) distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. ●All dogs must be up to date on rabies
