2.	I agree that when not working, the Dog must be secured in an ex-pen or crate in good repair. Failure to comply will result in dismissal from the event with no refund.				
3.	I agree that the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.				
4.	I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my "Related Parties"), damage to property and other losses.
