Attention Foreign Exhibitors - Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Post- dated cheques will NOT be accepted. Please DO NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank-you.

BORDER CROSSING — A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada, Government Regulations require a Certificate prior to entry into Canada.

Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice - All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at: (416) 675-5511 or Fax (416) 675 - 6506.

Temporary Competition Numbers or (TCN) – A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN off (Canine Companion Number) CCN. While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC by mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, score, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will updated accordingly.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

- **Section 1.** A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with several championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.
- **Section 2.** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9 1	0 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be not in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule - The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group, or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level

Best in Show (5 points)

b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) - The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title. Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship. A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

15.2.4 GRAND CHAMPION BRONZE (GChB) - The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. a. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand championship. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. c. Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five

(5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 GRAND CHAMPION SILVER (GChS) - a. The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group, or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 GRAND CHAMPION GOLD (GChG)

a) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group, or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- 15.3 GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT (GCh.Ex)
- **15.3.1** The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Champion Silver title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:
 - a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed National specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
 - b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
 - c) a CKC performance title from any CKC event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.
- **15.3.3** Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance Title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward it to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honored up until July 1, 2022.

REGULAR CLASSES

The following CKC classes (divided by sex; except Specials Only) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.
12 – 15 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.
15-18 MONTHS	Dogs between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class but need not
	handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs.
	For all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular
VETERAN CLASS	placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED
	(they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the Regular Classes or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-Regular classes.

Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

BABY PUPPY	Dogs between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show. These
	puppies may also compete in Sweepstakes if a 4–6-month class is offered.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may
	enter and compete in non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in

EXHIBITION ONLY (4-	provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These

PROGENY	Dog and Get apply to this classification.

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3 - A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.5 - A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3 - Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5 - An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1 - Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a) registered with the CKC
- b) have an Event Registration Number
- c) eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d) if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2 - A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonored cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque. **DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4** - Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are local Time.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

13. The Club has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with these shows, including spectators.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

Entry in Sweepstakes from the Exhibition Only class is not allowed - EXCEPT for puppies aged 4-6 months. These puppies may enter from the Baby Puppy Class or from the Exhibition (4-6 mos.) Class.

The following Classes will be offered (divided by sex):

4 - 6 months 6 - 9 months 9 - 12 months 12 - 15 months 15 - 18 months

75% of the total entry fees from each Class will be divided as follows:

- 1st in Class Ribbon and 20% of Class entry fees
- 2nd in Class Ribbon and 15% of Class entry fees
- 3rd in Class Ribbon and 10% of Class entry fees
- 4th in Class Ribbon and 5% of Class entry fees

Best in Sweepstakes - Rosette and 15% of Class entry fees **Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes** - Rosette and 10% of Class entry fees

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Entry in Sweepstakes from the Exhibition Only class is allowed.

The following Classes will be offered (divided by sex):

7 – under 9 years 9 – under 12 years 12+ years

75% of the total entry fees from each Class will be divided as follows:

- 1st in Class Ribbon and 20% of Class entry fees
- 2nd in Class Ribbon and 15% of Class entry fees
- 3rd in Class Ribbon and 10% of Class entry fees
- 4th in Class Ribbon and 5% of Class entry fees

Best in Sweepstakes: Rosette and 15% of Class entry fees

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes: Rosette and 10% of Class entry fees

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of the Edmonton Kennel Club Show & Trials if it:

- Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.
- Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or any other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to event).
- Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or any other communicable disease.

The Edmonton Kennel Club has the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

COVID 19 – The Edmonton Kennel Club recognizes the impact and risks that COVID-19 continues to have on our community. It is important to ensure the safety of our club members, volunteers, ring stewards, judges, and exhibitors. The EKC will follow all federal, provincial, municipal and facility protocols related to COVIS-19 that are in place at the time of the show, and by entering our show you agree to abide by these rules. If you have any objection to following our guidelines or restrictions, please do not enter this show.

If any club members, volunteers, ring stewards, judges or fellow exhibitors are subject to abusive language or behavior, or if you fail to abide by the show protocols, this may result in your dismissal from the show with no right of entry refund.

Please stay home if you are feeling sick.
