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## Qualifications and Rules for Entry

1. Previous Bronze Trophy & Don Cherry Trophy winners are **ineligible** to compete.
  2. Any Bull Terrier/Miniature Bull Terrier which has completed the requirements for a championship in their country is eligible to enter as a Champion.
  3. Any Bull Terrier /Miniature Bull Terrier which has not completed a championship but has been awarded ROM points at a Specialty or supported show under a breeder judge is eligible to enter the Champion Class.
  4. Any Bull Terrier/Miniature Bull Terrier which has not completed the requirements for a championship of their country or not been awarded ROM points is eligible to enter the the appropriate age class; 6-9 mos; 9-12 mos; 12-18 mos or Open.
  5. An officiating judge shall not own, co-own, or exhibit any entry at the Bronze Trophy nor Don Cherry Trophy.
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## Information: Bronze Trophy Show

1. These shows are NON-SANCTIONED CKC events and the rules have been established by The Fanciers BTmBT . NO CKC CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS ARE AWARED.
2. The BTCA has granted ROM points for the Bronze Trophy Show to be awarded according to the ROM Rules of the BTCA.
3. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
4. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied with proof of payment. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entry was made.
5. **ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE 8:00 P.M. ET, April 26, 2022 and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date & time.**

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**Judging Procedure:  
Bronze Trophy and  
Don Cherry Trophy  
Competitions**

1. One Judge will be assigned to judge the Dogs and the other will be assigned to judge the bitches.
2. Classes will be judged in order beginning with 6-9 mos. The winners of each individual class will be judged together to select an overall winner in Dogs and an overall winner in Bitches. **Only these two overall Winners** are eligible to go forward to compete against the Champions class for the Bronze/Don Cherry Trophy at which time a Best of Winners will be selected.
3. For the Bronze/Don Cherry Trophy all dogs will be judged as a group and all bitches will be judged as a group.
4. Judges must select a **minimum** of six finalists; at least three dogs and three bitches.
5. From the finalists each Judge shall select a WINNER and a RESERVE.
6. a) If the TROPHY WINNER AND RESERVE are of the same sex then each Judge will be asked to select a dog/bitch for Best of Opposite Sex.  
b) If both judges select the same dog/bitch for Best of Opposite Sex then this dog/bitch will be declared the Best of Opposite Sex to the Trophy Winner.  
c) If the judges select different dogs for Best of Opposite Sex then the REFEREE will select between the two dogs and declare the BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX WINNER.
7. After the Bronze Trophy Winner, Reserve and BOS have been chosen, The Best Opposite Color (Variety) of the Trophy will be chosen. This can be either sex.
8. Each Judge shall select his//her choice for BEST MOVER, from all of the entrants. If both Judges select a different dog/bitch, the REFEREE will select between those two to declare the MOVEMENT TROPHY WINNER.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. **Entries close 8 P.M. (ET) Tuesday, April 26, 2022, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.**
5. Identification cards and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.
6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$35 service charge.**

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## General Information

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. The Bull Terrier Fanciers Association will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule.
6. SHOW PRECINCTS: The show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges, exhibitors and handlers.

**NOTE: The Show Superintendent may restrict the placing of chairs, tables and crates and may limit the use of private exercise pens during show hours.**

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### Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.

The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

***A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN).***

TCNs can be obtained:

- Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);
- By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or
- By contacting the Shows & Trials Division Toll Free: 1-855-364-7252.

***Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.***

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### Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Fee is \$64.00 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

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### Non-Member Participation Fee

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$170.00 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

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## Specialty Classes

*(both sexes)*

### **REGULAR CLASSES:**

**JUNIOR PUPPY** – A dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

**SENIOR PUPPY** – A dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

**12-18 MONTHS** – A dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.

**CANADIAN BRED** – A dog born in Canada.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** – Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

**OPEN CLASS** – For all dogs.

**VETERANS CLASS** – For all dogs over 7 years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs compete for the regular placements, and the 1st-place dog and bitch will compete for Best of Breed. Veterans may be broken down into separate age categories. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

**ALTERED** – Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age that have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

**SPECIALS ONLY** – Dogs that are Canadian Champions.

### **NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES:**

**BABY PUPPY** – A dog between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show. Baby Puppies do not compete for points.

**EXHIBITION ONLY** – All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in Regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular/Unofficial classes and/or Parades.

## CH and Champion Points

**Section 15.1.1** A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

**Section 15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*\*includes the dog awarded Winners*

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

**Section 15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

**Section 15.1.11** A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

## GCH and Grand Champion Points

**Section 15.2.1** The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

**15.2.2** Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

**Section 15.2.3** To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

- a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

- b) The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at group level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

#### **Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)**

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.



### **Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)**

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

### **Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)**

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

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### **GCHEX and Grand Champion Excellent Points**

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

**Section 15.3.2** To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

**Section 15.3.3** Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

**NOTE:** Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.

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## Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Section 4.7.3** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

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## Moving Class Dog to Specials Only

**Section 8.9** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

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## NEW – Moving Back to the Classes

**Section 8.10.5** A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.



## HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

***Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.***

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## Motels / Hotels

Motels request exhibitors to clean up after their dogs on Motel grounds. Owners will be responsible and liable for any damage. Please co-operate, we want the Motels to welcome our exhibitors and their dogs again next year.
