GENERAL INFORMATION AND EVENT RULES

ELIGIBILITY: Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 6 months

of age that:

(a) Are individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number),

- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed.

Dogs that are eligible for a CKC or ERN number but don't yet have one should have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). These can be obtained free of charge online from the CKC. For this event, dogs may still be run as "Listed". For more information about the TCN:

ENTRY LIMIT: Trials are limited to 120 Novice and Open runs on Saturday and 60 runs on Sunday. Day of trial entries will NOT be accepted at this event. If the trials fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

Handlers may only enter 1 dog in each component at each level. Dogs can only be entered in Open, Excellent or Master components if they have already qualified at the preceding level in that component.

MOVE UPS: There will be no move ups in this trial.

EQUIPMENT: The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness during the search. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn during the search. Harnesses may have the leash

attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the grounds.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. If a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the club will refund the entry fee providing the event secretary receives, on or before the event, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial.

TEST SITE: No indoor kenneling. These tests will be run **rain or shine**. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the trial where off leash searches are permitted. <u>Flexi leads will</u> <u>not be allowed on the test site</u>. Remember that this is a public park used by families. Clean up after yourself and your dog.

Bathroom facilities are on site. A concession is available at Planet Ice within walking distance of the venue.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

BORDER CROSSING: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.
