To compete, non-pure breed and unrecognized-breed dog owners must apply for a Canine Companion Number (CCN) to complete their entry & meet the criteria as set out in the Canine Companion Club Policy.

Entries for each Trial will close automatically when 50 runs have been reached, even if the official closing date for entries has not arrived.

Trial and General Information:

1. Ribbons: Rosettes will be awarded for Qualifying Scores and flat ribbons for 1st -4th placement in each class. Rosettes will be awarded for HIT for each – Trial 1 and Trial 2 and High Qualifying Belgian in Trial 1 and Trial 2.
2. Move- ups are permitted. Trial Secretary must receive completed move-up form 30 minutes before the beginning of class.
3. Order of events. Trial 1: Standard 1- Excellent, Intermediate, Novice, Standard 2 – Novice, Intermediate, Excellent. Trial 2: JWW 1 – Excellent, Intermediate, Novice, JWW 2 – Novice, Intermediate, Excellent.
4. Participants in the trials will be required to volunteer.
5. Timing will be manual. Electronic timer is not being used.
6. Venue: 100' x 110' Enclosed Ring ~ Outdoors ~ On Sand. Agility ring and surrounds are uncovered. In the event of inclement weather, no cover will be provided. Indoor crating area will be available.
7. Trial Precincts: Outside - the area includes the agility ring and the area inside of the main gates; Inside - the area of the building designated by the Trial Committee for indoor crating and areas designated for the use of the Trial Secretary, Judge and Committee.
8. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a refund of the entry fee will be made as long as a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, reaches the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial.
9. No equipment familiarization will be offered for Novice dogs.
10. No entry will be accepted that is incomplete or that is submitted without entry fees. Tendering of a NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC Rule 13.7.2). Charges for any NSF cheques issued to the BSDCC Atlantic Section will be \$35.00. No post-dated cheques will be accepted. Overpayment of entry fees less than \$10.00 will not be refunded.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
14. Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

NON-PUREBRED DOGS REQUIRE A CCN TO COMPLETE THEIR ENTRY:

These trials are open to non-purebred dogs. If entering your non-purebred dog (includes mixed-breed and unrecognized-breed) in these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number to complete the entry form. Non-Member Participation Fee (Canadian residents):

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a “non-member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice:

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to CKC. Take the exit on the left onto HWY--118 S toward Halifax/HWY--111/HWY--103/Dartmouth

Take exit 13W to merge onto Akerley Blvd/HWY--107 W toward Akerley Blvd/Burnside Ind. Park Continue to follow Akerley Blvd. Turn left at Joseph Zatzman Dr.

From Halifax:

Take the MacKay Bridge to Dartmouth, merge onto HWY--111 N.

Take exit 3 for Burnside Industrial Park toward Highfield Park Dr., turn left at Burnside Dr/Highfield Park Dr. Continue to follow Burnside Dr., turn left at Wright Ave, and Turn right at Joseph Zatzman Dr.
