About UKI Agility Programs

Speedstakes Titling Program

Speedstakes Program consists of classes made up of only jumps and tunnels (not including spread or long jumps). The Program allows dogs to move up through the levels by gathering the required number of points in each level.

SS Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for SS Novice, SS Senior and SS Champion levels in the Speed Stakes Program.

SS Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points in the SS Beginners classes. Or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.

International Titling Program

The International Program consists of agility, jumping (including weave poles), and games classes (like Gamblers). The Program allows dogs to progress through the levels by gathering the required number of points in the aforementioned classes. The purpose of this program is to reward the well-rounded dog who may only progress through the levels with stipulated points in each of the class types.

Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for Novice, Senior and Champion levels in the International Program

Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points, where 8 of those points must be obtained in agility classes.

UKI Jump Height Categories

Jump Height	Dog's Height	A-frame height
8 inch	11" & under	5'3"
12 inch	14" & under	5'3"
16 inch	17.5" & under	5'7"
20 inch	22 & under	5'7"
22 inch	Over 22"	5'7"
24 inch	Over 22"	5'7"
4 inch Select & Nursery	Any	5'3"

Dogs are measured while in a standing position on a flat surface. The measurement is taken from the top of the dog's withers. All dogs, except the 24 & 22 inch divisions and the 20inch Select, must have an official measurement when at their first (real) show (not required for this fun match).
