Heelwork

Friday, May 31

All levels of dogs and handlers welcome. The heelwork seminar will focus on correct positions and building drive in heeling. This workshop is suitable for those geared towards competitive Obedience and Rally-O, as well as Heelwork to Music.

Beginner Dogdancing

Saturday, June 1

Suitable for novice handlers, this day will include:

- Training of individual Heel positions and Freestyle moves
- Beginning distance work
- Restricting hand signals in routine
- How to create a balanced routine
- Differences in shaping/ luring, how to build drive, timing of rewards

Advanced Dogdancing

Sunday, June 2

Suitable for intermediate and advanced handlers, this day will include:

- Linking moves together (building flow in routine)
 - increasing duration of behaviours and adding distractions (applause, large crowds of people etc)
 - Suitable use of moves, integration and use of props, appropriate music selection, what to avoid, building choreography

Workshop Information

Seminar will be held in a covered agility barn with a dirt floor, located at 3564 - 224th Street, Langley, BC.

Parking is free, coffee and refreshments will be available. A lunch will be provided, though we may not be able to cater to dietary restrictions. Bring a chair and pen & paper to take notes. Your dog must be able to rest in a crate or x-pen when not working. You will need high value treats and toys to train with during the workshop. Your dog should have a flat collar and 6' leash. A working spot is for 1 person and 1 dog per day.

Vanda Gregorova has been training dogs for over 15 years. Vanda is a world-renowned competitor and judge of Musical Freestyle and Heelwork to Music. She started competing in 2004, and began judging in 2011. She is on the judging panel for the Crufts 2019 International Heelwork to Music Freestyle competition. The basis of her training is teamwork and enthusiasm. She uses reward based training to get the best out of each dog- using praise, food, and toys as rewards, and a mix of shaping and luring techniques to achieve the desired behaviours. Vanda lives in Prague with her 2 Australian Shepherds and 3 Chihuahuas.
