Barn hunt searches are similar to nose work, as dogs must use their noses to locate the proper tube that contains the rat.

Dogs carry-out these searches in a barn or horse arena area, searching through bales of hay and straw. This is a very natural sport for our dogs and because of this it is a sport that dogs thoroughly enjoy.

This is the first Barn Hunt Search being offered in the Maritimes, so please consider bringing your dog out for a fun day and to make a bit of history
