#### **CKC AGILITY TITLES**

#### **Standard**

#### Jumpers with Weaves

AG.N. – Agility NoviceAG.N.J. – Agility Novice JumperAG.I. – Agility IntermediateAG.I.J. – Agility Intermediate JumperAG.X. – Agility ExcellentAG.X.J. – Agility Excellent JumperAG.M.X. – Agility Master ExcellentAG.M.X.J. – Agility Master Excellent JumperAG.M.CH. – may be used for dogs which achieve the AGMX and AGMXJ titles.CKC permits the use of a number indicating a Masters level title earned a second, third or fourth time e.g. AG.M.X.2 and so on.

<u>Steeplechase</u> AG.SC – Agility Steeplechase, 10 qualifying scores. AG.SC.X – Agility Steeplechase Excellent, 25 qualifying scores

Titles also available in the new PAD class (Points and Distance). PAD class not offered at our 2014 trials.

#### Selected and Veteran Titles

Titles for Selected include an "S" at the end of the title e.g. AG.N.S. Titles for Veterans include a "V" at the end of the title.

#### CLASSES

Novice replaces Novice A and Novice B. Excellent replaces Excellent A. Master Excellent replaces Excellent B.

**Agility Novice** (Standard & Jumpers with Weaves): Open to any dog that has not earned a qualifying score in the CKC Agility Intermediate Class. Novice Standard and Novice Jumpers with Weaves will have one set of 6 weave poles, used once.

**Agility Intermediate** (Standard & Jumpers with Weaves): Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.

**Agility Excellent** (Standard & Jumpers with Weaves): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Master Excellent (Standard & Jumpers with Weaves): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.

Steeplechase: One level, jumpers style course with weave poles and A-Frame. Scoring - time plus faults.

#### Divisions – Regular, Selected, Veterans

#### Selected Classes

Any dog eligible to participate in a CKC agility trial may enter the Selected Class. In the Selected Classes, dogs jump one height lower than their regular jump height and the Standard Course Time is increased by 10%. Once a dog is entered in Selected Classes, the dog may not go back to compete in the Regular classes. Dogs move laterally and take any legs they have earned in the Regular classes with them.

#### Veteran Classes

Dogs 7 years or older may be entered into the Veterans division at one OR two heights lower than their Regular jump height. Dogs entered in Veterans may NOT move back into Regular or Selected. The dog will retain titles and/or qualifying scores accumulated towards titles, and will have the same 10% additional Standard Course Time as Selected dogs.

#### JUMP HEIGHTS (one height lower than Regular for Selected, one or two heights lower than Regular for Veterans)

- 4 inches (Selected and Veterans only)
- 8 inches for dogs 10" and under
- 12 inches for dogs over 10" up to and including 14"
- 16 inches for dogs over 14" up to and including 18"
- 20 inches for dogs over 18" up to and including 22"
- 24 inches for dogs over 22"

Height of tire will be 4" lower than the jump height for other jumps, except for the 4" jump height. For example, if a dog jumps 20", the tire jump will be 16".

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

#### EQUIPMENT/PERFORMANCE CHANGES:

- ✤ A-Frame set at 5' for 12", 8" and 4" jump heights.
- Overall length of closed tunnel is 10'-12'.
- Pause Table The dog is not required to sit or lie down on the table. The table count is continuous and begins as soon as 4 paws are on the table.

Check the CKC Agility Rule Book 2014 for all the changes and updates.

#### ENTRIES

- 1. All dogs must be individually registered with the CKC or eligible for CKC registration.
- 2. The entry form must be completed in every respect and exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.
- 3. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- 4. The tendering of a dishonoured (NSF) cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence subject to disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

#### Attention U.S. Exhibitors Payment of entry fees:

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we recommend that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

#### Attention Non-CKC members CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

#### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- 1. The precinct of the trials shall be the ring enclosure and 10 feet surrounding.
- 2. Only dogs entered for competition will be permitted in the precinct of the trials.
- 3. No provisions have been made for rain or sun. Bring your chair and protection from the weather for yourself and your dog.
- 4. Please do not litter. Use the designated area for your dog, and then clean up.
- 5. Dogs must be under control at all times and kept on a leash except in the warm up area and on the course.
- 6. No food or other device will be allowed on the course. The dog may wear a buckle collar, a quick release collar or no collar on the course.
- 7. Competitors participate at this event at their own risk. The release form must be signed.
- 8. All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- 9. Club Agilité Canin de St-Lazare reserves the right to refuse entries, subject to CKC rules.
- 10. Electronic timing will be used.

#### **MOVE-UPS**

A dog earning a title after the closing date may advance to a higher level providing the Trial Secretary is notified one week prior to the trial. Move-ups will be permitted between the Saturday and Sunday trials. The move-up form must be completed and handed to the Trial Secretary on Saturday by the end of the second trial.

#### ALTERNATE LIST, REFUNDS

- 1. No entries may be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the closing date.
- 2. In the event that the entry limit is reached before the official closing date, an Alternate List will be compiled in the order received. Alternate dogs will be allowed to run in the place of any absent dogs. Alternate dogs which are not able to run shall have the entry fees refunded.
- 3. There shall be no refunds in the event that the dog is absent on the day of the trial, or if the dog/handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event of inclement weather, other than as provided for below.
- 4. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes in season after the entry has been submitted, a refund will be made on submission of a veterinary certificate prior to the day of the trial, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial.
- 5. When a dog has become injured after the closing date, a refund will be made on submission of a veterinary certificate prior to the day of the trial, certifying that the dog has sustained injury

#### AWARDS

In all classes: Rosettes/ribbons from 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place for dogs with qualifying scores in each division and height category. All dogs with a qualifying score will be awarded a flat qualifying ribbon. A Club Agilité Canin de St-Lazare special rosette will be awarded for a CKC title achieved at these trials.

#### **CKC AGILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS - CONDUCT**

Section 18.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report that this has occurred.

#### EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Dogs that are foreign-born and owned who enter Canada for the sole purpose of competing in CKC events do not require a CKC registration number, but do require an Event Registration Number. (ERN) This must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event. 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# **Canine Companion Number (CCN)**

#### 1 Definitions

- a) **Mixed breed dog**: is a dog of unknown ancestry that belongs to no recognized breed and is not the result of selective breeding.
- b) **Unrecognized breed**: is a dog of known ancestry not on the CKC list of recognized or miscellaneous breeds and that is registered with a Registry recognized by the CKC.
- c) **Recognized breed**: is a breed that CKC is authorized to register in accordance with the Animal Pedigree Act (APA) or a dog of a breed included in the CKC Miscellaneous Breed list

#### 2 Purpose

a) A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows mixed and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events of Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials.

#### 3 Eligibility

- a) In order for a dog to receive a Canine Companion Number (CCN) the following criteria must be met:
  - 1) The dog must be either a mixed breed or unrecognized breed as defined herein.
  - 2) Mixed breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
  - 3) The dog must be identified with a Canadian Kennel Club approved microchip.
- 4 Applying for a Canine Companion Number (CCN)

Complete the appropriate Canadian Kennel Club Canine Companion Number application form.

With the completed form, accompanying documentation must be included as follows:

- 1. Mixed breed dogs proof of spay or neuter.
- 2. Unrecognized dogs not eligible for registration by CKC and not on the Miscellaneous List a copy of a registration certificate from a CKC recognized Registry.
- 3. The appropriate fee as noted in the CKC fee schedule.
- 5 Upon receipt of a Canine Companion Number (CCN), the dog may be entered in any of the events noted in 2 a.
- 6 A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.
- 7 The Canadian Kennel Club may cancel for cause, any Canine Companion Number.
