Official CKC Entry forms MUST be used. If other forms are used they must be of the same size and have the <u>information in the same order</u>. Please photocopy the enclosed entry forms if you require more than were supplied.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES accepted. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$20.00.

N.S.F. Cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention Foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At **Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank** drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you



All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via The Entry Line. The Halifax Kennel Club does not accept credit cards for payment.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent

emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official CKC entry form. **Please type or print clearly.**
- INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please note that full name and address of owners <u>MUST</u> be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned.
- 3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 4. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing time and date.
- 5. Only dogs entered may attend these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

SWEEPSTAKES: All VARIETIES

JUVENILE: This class is open to all Dachshunds from 6 months to under 18 months regardless of their place of birth. Dogs must also be entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty. Classes will be divided by sex as follows: 6 to 9 months, 9 to 12 months, 12-18 months. **PRIZES**: Rosettes are offered for Best in Sweepstakes, Best of Opposite and First in Class. Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each class. Best in Sweepstakes: 30% of total fees

Best of Opposite in Sweeps: 10% of total fees

First in class: 40% of class fees.

VETERAN: This class is open to all Dachshunds 7 years and older regardless of their place of birth Dogs must also be

entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty or exhibition only. Spayed or Neutered Dachshunds are eligible for this

event. Classes will be divided as follows: 7 years to 9 years; 9 to 11 years and 11 years plus. **PRIZES:** Rosette is offered for Best in Sweepstakes. Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each class. Prize money will be allocated as follows.

Best in Sweepstakes: 30% of total fees

Best of Opposite in Sweeps: 10% of total fees

First in class: 40% of class fees.

Balance of fees retained by club.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Junior Handling registration will be at the show secretaries table. Complete entries only. Entry deadline is one hour before the start of the event. Best Overall offered.

Rosettes are offered for Overall and first in Class. Remainder of awards receive a flat ribbon. A prize is offered for the Best Overall Junior Handler.

Rosettes will be offered at each breed level for Best Veteran in Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch. Flats will be offered for 1st to 4th in Class

A rosette and suitable prize will be awarded to any Dachshund who achieves a High in Trial in Obedience at the Saturday HKC trial.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler .
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The Specialty Club and East Hants Sportsplex will not be held responsible for any equipment left on the grounds overnight.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- The Specialty Club and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the ECDC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.

Only dogs entered in the Shows will be permitted on the show premises.

No dogs shall be permitted to remain in the building overnight

The precincts of the show shall be the building and the entrances to it..
