### General Information

1. The show has been limited to 200 humans on the specialty field at any one time. The 200 human limit applies to entrants, judges, ASSCA/CCC members and all persons present (including spouse, significant other, family members).

2. Take your win ribbon only if you plan on keeping it. Do not give ribbons back to the ASSCA/CCC.

3. The show secretary's designated space will be considered sacred ground. Barriers will be set up using a 6 Feet / 2 Metre perimeter to protect the show secretary. Anyone who violates the space of the show secretary will be asked to leave the show grounds and may not return for the duration of the show. No refunds for entries will be provided in this instance.

### Show Practices

1. Each exhibitor will complete a waiver of liability for ASSCA/CCC and Wet Noses Inc as part of their entry (either online entry or mailed entry). No one will be allowed to participate who has not completed the required waiver. If you enter online, please print and bring a copy of your signed waiver. If you enter via a mailed entry, please ensure your paper entry includes a copy of your signed wavier.

#### **General Required Practices**

1. ASSCA and CCC members, judges and exhibitors are required to follow Federal, Provincial, Local and facility guidelines as presented below. Any changes in guidelines between the posting of this Premium List and the starting of each show will also be followed.

2. Social distancing must be practiced. Maintain a distance of 6 feet / 2 Metres or more unless individuals are part of a family or cohort unit.

3. Masks are required on the show grounds and when showing your dog. Masks are provided by the exhibitors for their personal use. Masks are required in all common areas where social distancing is not guaranteed.

4. Show and Go Rules are in effect – once your breed judging is complete you are required to leave the show grounds and return to your vehicle or your camping spot. Do not enter the show grounds more than 1 hour before

### **NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES**

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes.

<u>Please note</u>: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone <u>but</u> written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary <u>before the official date and time of entry closing</u>. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

<u>ERRORS IN ENTRIES</u>: An error in an <u>age-specified class, date of birth or sex</u>, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined by the CKC will apply to this specialty.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 3. A judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under CKC rules shall not be subject to any indignity (CKC dog show rules, 19.7).

#### \*\* TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBERS (TCN) \*\*

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent CKC registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained BEFORE submitting an entry for any event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

# The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

#### ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan. 1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will</u> require an <u>ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$62.40 plus 5% GST** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. #### CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is is \$62.40 plus 5% GST.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by <u>Canadian resident non-CKC members</u> and are not applicable to CKC members"
