

Judging will commence at 8:00 am unless entries warrant an earlier or later starting time. All Group Judging will commence on completion of Breed Judging within each group.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

CKC HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;

Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);

Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

At events where judges will be checking bites, judges should be encouraged to have the exhibitors show the bite. If the judge insists on checking bites themselves, they are expected to use hand sanitizer or soap and water in between each exhibit. Please ensure that sanitizer wipes and bottles of hand sanitizer are available at all times at events.

No other entry service is authorized to take entries for these events.

All entries paid by Credit Card, Debit Card, or eTransfer MUST be done via The Entry Line.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. All entries must be received on or before the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper fees.
- 2. Remember your entry can only be as accurate as the information you provide. The Show Secretary (or Entry Service) is NOT RESPONSIBLE for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Moving class dogs to specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
- 3. Agents and Handlers, please note that **full name and address of owners <u>MUST</u>** be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. **(Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)**

- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made. Please review email confirmations so corrections may be made **prior to closing date** to avoid disappointment. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries before the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries. Until the closing date any changes to your entry can be made via The Entry Line, after the closing date please contact the Show Secretary.
- 5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time.
- 6. Only dogs entered in the Shows may enter the venue. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Service Dogs are welcome
- 7. The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes: It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules and Regulation. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

REFUND POLICY

If because of; an act of God, riot, civil disturbance, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations, or decree, or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the TKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the Non-Member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account. A dog may not move to the Specials class with a TCN. The dog must be fully registered with the CKC – CKC registration, ERN or MCN.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023**, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership to CKC, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide your full return address to enable to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicated your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. Please forward

Junior Handling (Conformation)

Junior handling will be held Saturday & Sunday during the lunch break. Dogs competing in junior handling must be entered in the show in one of the regular classes or on exhibition only. Registration will take place each morning (by 11:00 am) at the Secretary's table. Entry fee is \$2.00 (correct change is appreciated)

Catalogues

Entry Line Armband Draw

THE ENTRY LINE 35th Anniversary Armband Draw

The Entry Line will be offering a \$35 gift certificate to their service to the winner of a random armband draw in recognition of their 35th Anniversary.

This draw will be conducted prior to the event and when the exhibitor picks up their armband, they will also see the Show Secretary to pick up their gift certificate.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Tantramar Kennel Club, its officers, associates, Show Committee and Little Moe's Canine Academy, will use due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. The Tantramar Kennel Club (and Little Moe's Canine Academy) will not be responsible for equipment left on site overnight.
- The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials, which are governed by CKC rules
- The site will be open no earlier than 12:00 noon until 4:00pm and again after 6:00 pm until dark on Friday May 17th for set-up. The site will be open at 7:00 AM Saturday and Sunday. Please be aware that this is also a place of business & that there will be other customers coming in on Saturday and Sunday mornings so it will be busy during that time. No Exhibitors will be allowed in for set-up between 4:00 6:00 pm on Friday as that time is reserved for business customers.
- NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT ON SITE OVERNIGHT.
- BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring grounds.
- Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely was possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged. It is the responsibility of the

- owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- Due to the limited amount of space, the Superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the Superintendent in this regard.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- Please keep your dogs crated when unattended, and clean up after your dogs.
- SHOW PRECINCTS The precincts of the show shall be the fenced area of the rings and 3 feet surrounding the rings.
- **Parking** Yan Mowatt, and her staff, will be in complete charge of parking. Everyone is to abide by their instructions as they know the ground on the site and where best to park your vehicle.
- **Tents & Pop-Ups** Please contact Yan Mowat directly at yan@littlemoesk9academy.com (please put Tantramar Dog Show in the Subject line) to reserve a spot for a tent or pop-up. Sites must be pre-booked and are first come first served.
- Food: The Barnyard Grill food truck will be onsite both days. MacDonalds restaurant is 1 minute away, Tim Hortons & multiple other restaurants are 5 minutes away. Some restaurants will deliver to the property.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show Junior Puppy A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show

Senior Puppy A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show 12-18 Months A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show

Canadian Bred A dog which was born in Canada

Bred by Exhibitor A dog owned and handled by the breeder

Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions

Exhibition Only Dogs 6 months and over, not in competition.

Altered class For sexually altered dogs only

NOTE: 4–6-month Exhibition only puppy~ if the puppy does not yet have a CKC Registration Number the Listing Fee is waived.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

All exhibitors will be held responsible for CLEAN-UP in the show rings, on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their own dogs or dogs they are handling.

Additionally, CLEAN-UP after your dog(s) at your motel or campground.
